Medbery Bike Trail

Michigan



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The Medbery Bike Trail runs from a junction with the [Hart-Montague Trail State Park](#) and [White Lake Pathway](#) in Montague, Michigan, to an industrial park west of town. The rail-trail passes primarily through a woodland landscape, but trail users may be able to catch a glimpse of White Lake and the City of Whitehall across the water from the trail's northern end.

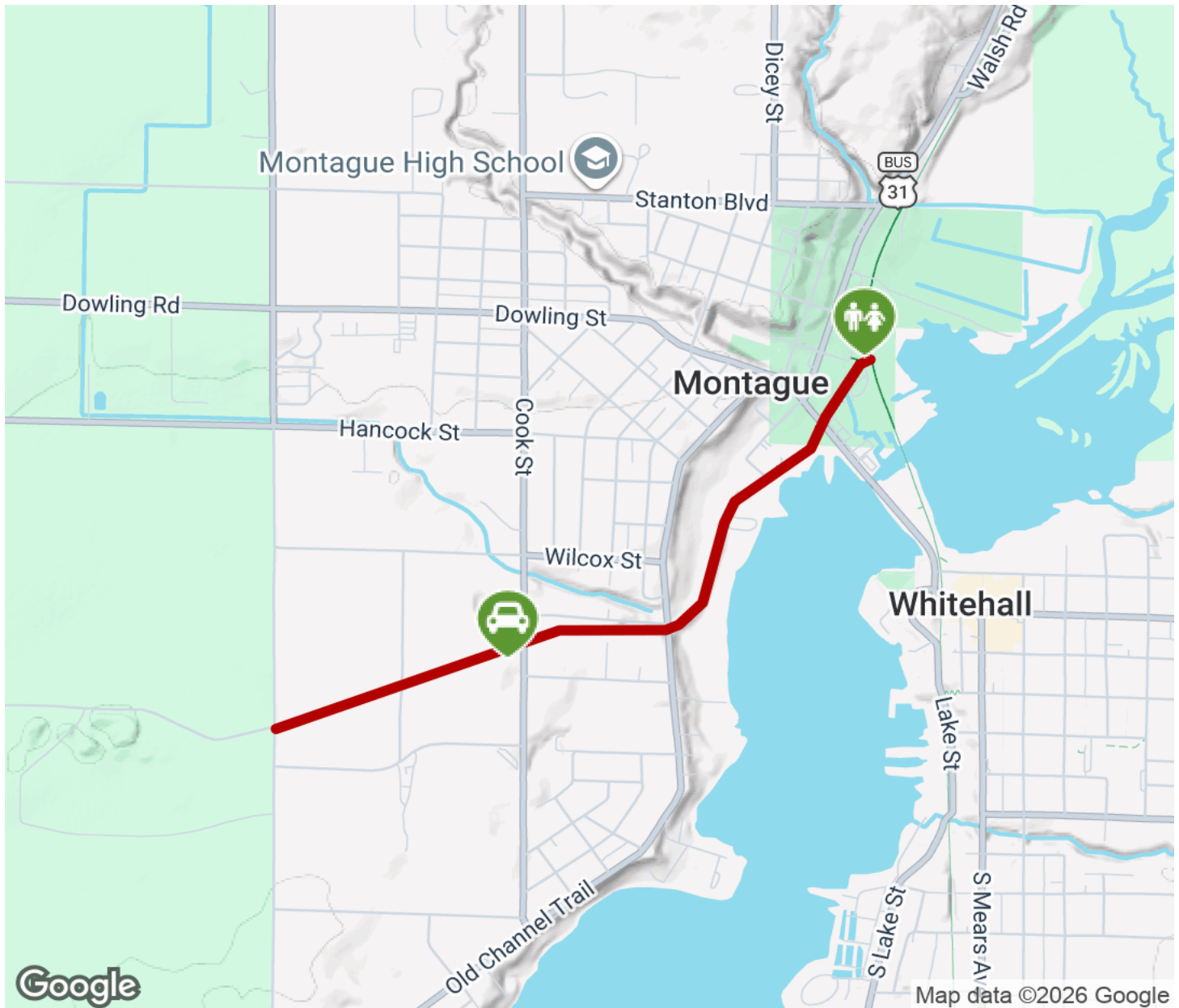
Parking & Trail Access
