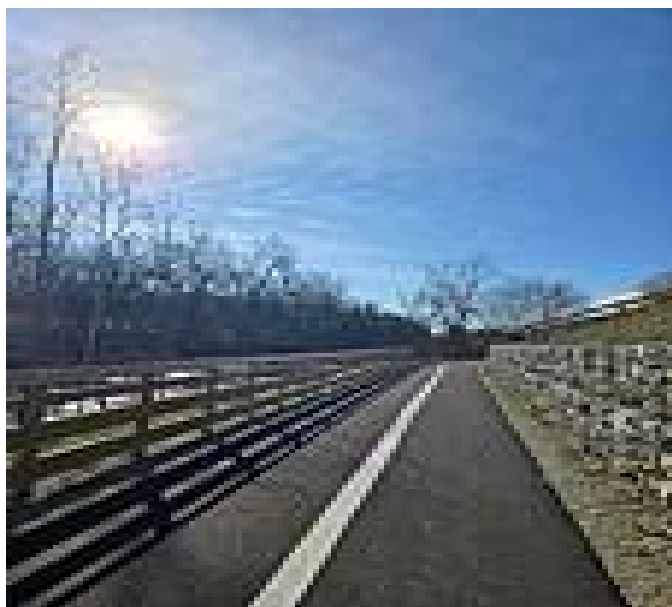

The paved trail parallels the Miami River through dense woodlands as it makes its way to Kuther Road.

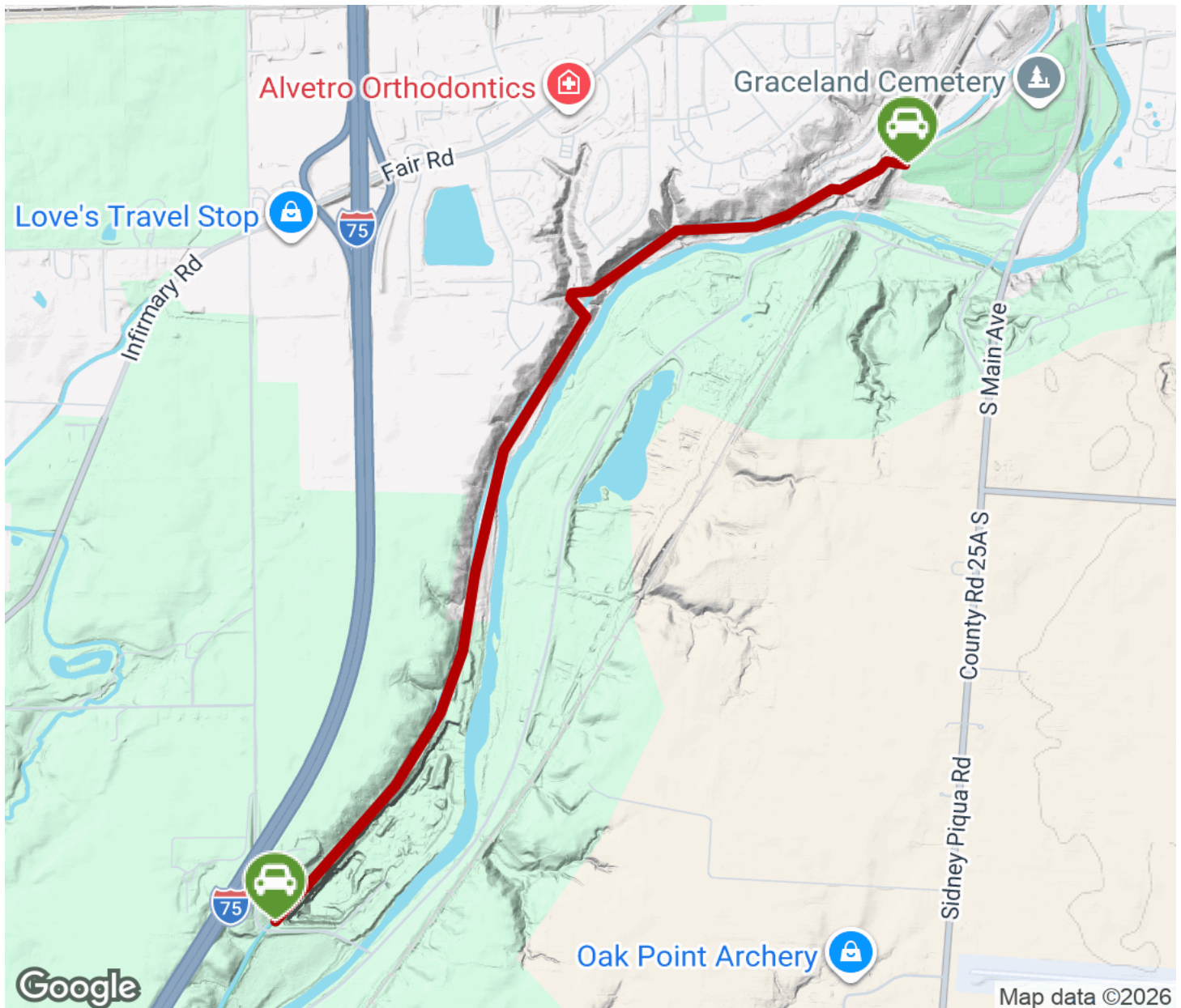
## Parking & Trail Access
