The Renova Heritage Walking Trail provides a short path for exercise on a former Yazoo and Mississippi Valley Railroad (later Illinois Central Railroad) corridor. The wide paved trail in the tiny community of Renova features benches and trash cans along its entire length and is one of several trails open on the out-of-service corridor. The others are [Shelby Trails](#) and the [Duncan Walking Trail](#) to the north and Cleveland's [Crosstie Walk](#), [Boyle Rail-Trail](#), [Shaw Rail-Trail](#) and [Hollandale Rail-Trail](#) to the south.


Parking & Trail Access
