Although short, the Marymoor Connector Trail provides an important link between the <u>Sammamish River Trail</u> (an 11-mile route that heads north to Bothell and the <u>Burke-Gilman Trail</u>) and the <u>East Lake Sammamish Trail</u> (which heads 11 miles south to Issaquah). All are part of a vast and growing regional network of trails stretching from Puget Sound to the Cascade Mountains. The trail's route across King County's Marymoor Park is pleasant and paved, but does not offer much shade.
