Although Scott's Branch Trail is short (just over a mile), it's a beautiful gem in western Columbia, traversing both the Columbia Audubon Nature Sanctuary and Bonnie View Nature Sanctuary. (Note that dogs are not permitted in these areas.)

The paved trail also connects to Dublin Park, which offers a playground and picnic tables, and Fairview Park, where you can find soccer fields, volleyball and tennis courts, a playground, restrooms, and picnic tables.


Parking is available in Fairview Park (1001 Fairview Road) and Bonnie View Nature Sanctuary (3300 Rollins Road).
