Although Scott's Branch Trail is short (just over a mile), it's a beautiful gem in western Columbia, traversing both the Columbia Audubon Nature Sanctuary and Bonnie View Nature Sanctuar (Note that dogs are not permitted in these areas.)

The paved trail also connects to Dublin Park, which offers a playground and picnic tables, and Fairview Park, where there are soccer fields, volleyball and tennis courts, a playground, restrooms, and picnic tables.


