Shortly after its beginning at Market Street (one block from Main Street), the paved trail dives into woodlands, winding its way west for just over a half-mile. At its western end, it directly connects with the [Noon Day Creek Trail](#), which heads south for another mile.

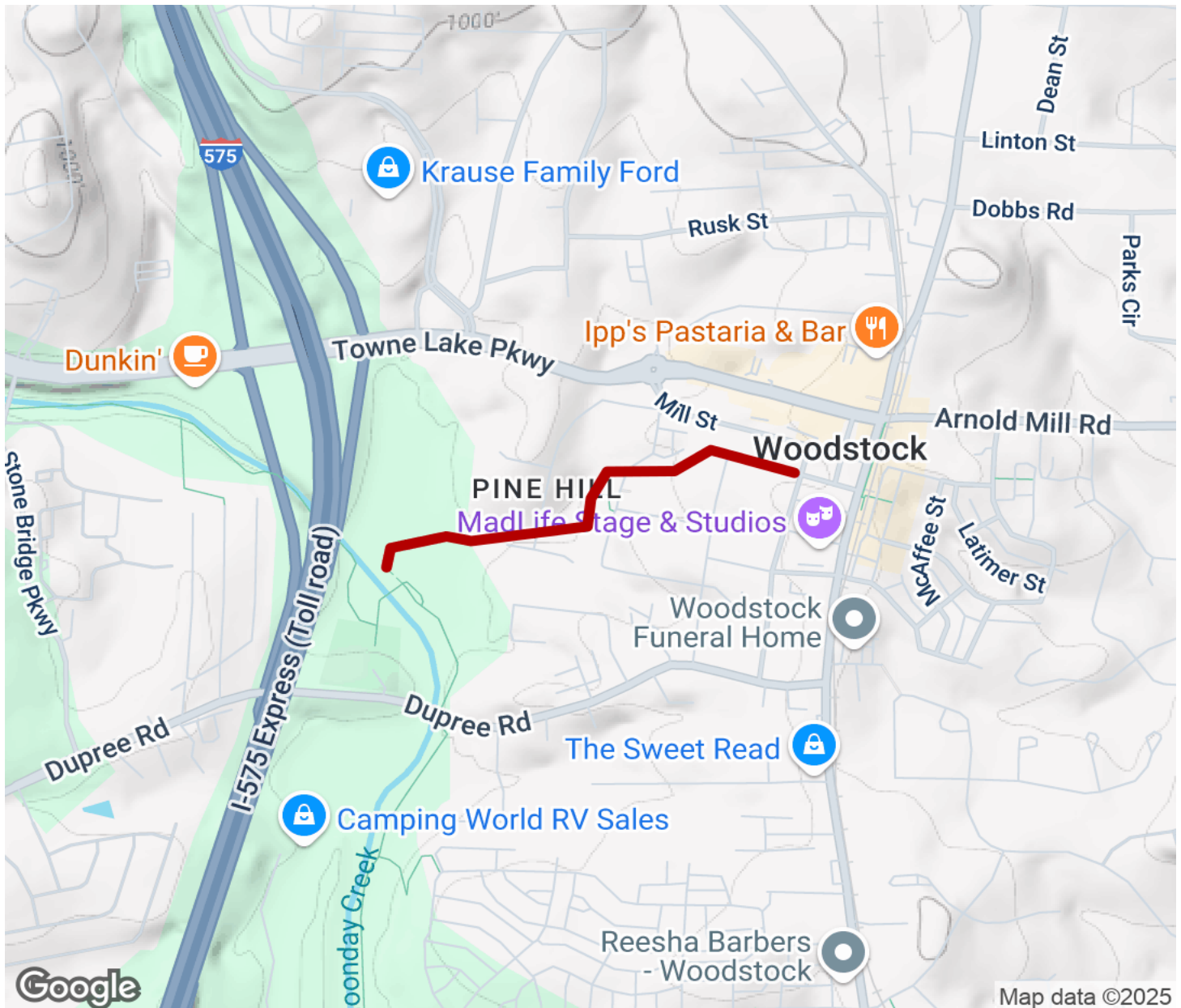
Parking & Trail Access
