# Ellicott Creek Trailway

*New York*



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Ellicott Creek Trailway is an asphalt path used for biking, walking, running, and rollerblading.

## About the Route

This multiuse pathway travels along Ellicott Creek—a 47-mile waterway that flows from Bennington to the Niagara River. Located in Amherst, it also rides the outskirts of the University at Buffalo campus.

## Parking & Trail Access


