The Hoover Scenic Trail continues north from the paved [Genoa Trail](#) to Weise Road just south of Galena. The trail follows the northwestern shoreline of the sprawling Hoover Reservoir within a scenic nature preserve. A highlight of the trail's short length is a bicycle and pedestrian bridge over Old 3C Highway.

Both the Hoover Scenic Trail and Genoa Trail are components of the [Ohio to Erie Trail](#). The planned 320-mile route, of which over 240 miles are complete and open for use, will eventually span Ohio from the shores of Lake Erie in Cleveland to the Ohio River in Cincinnati.

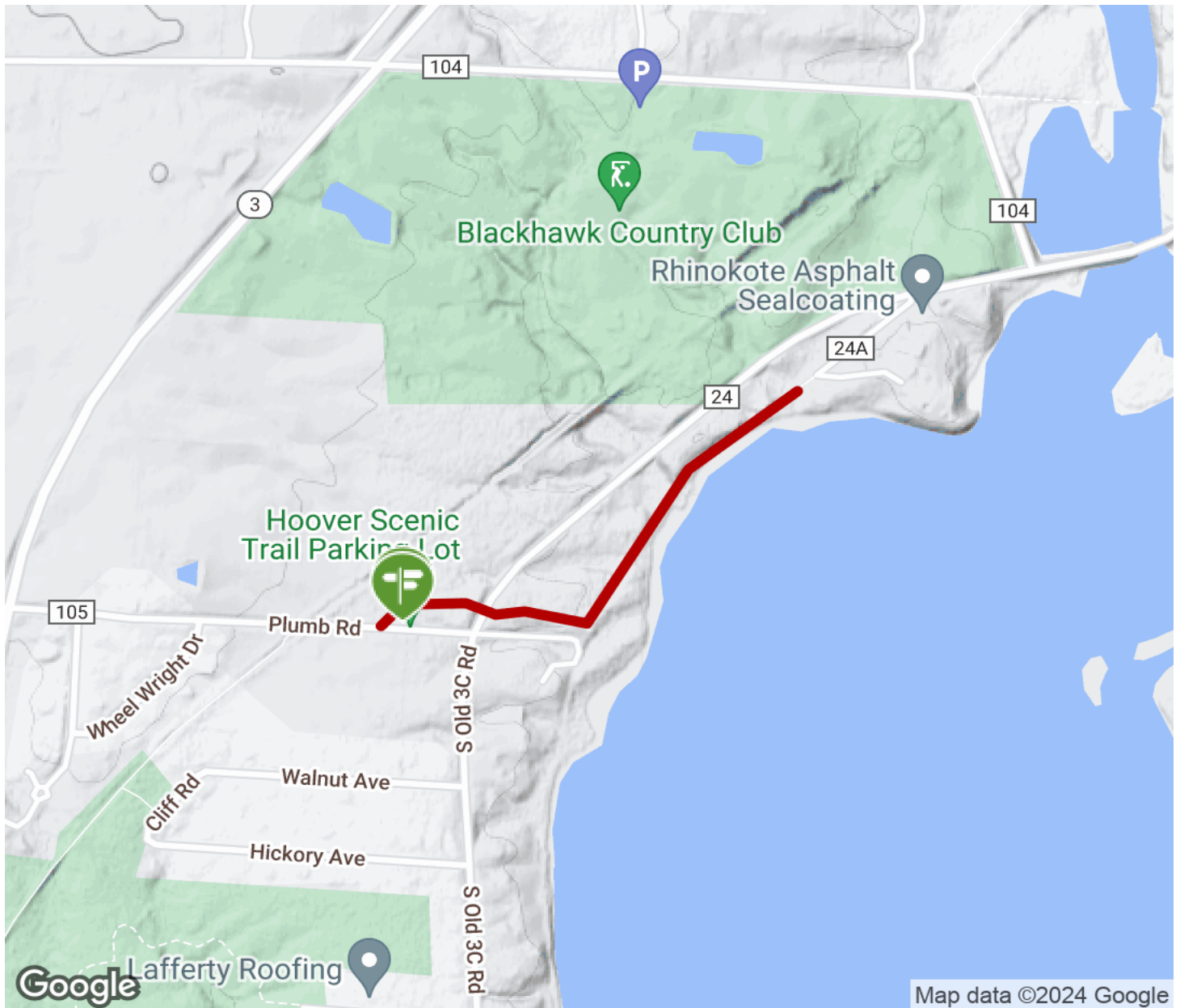
Parking & Trail Access
