The 312 RiverRun is a 1.1-mile biking and walking trail located on Chicago's northside along the North Branch of the Chicago River,



The 312 RiverRun is a 1.1-mile biking and walking trail located on Chicago's northside along the North Branch of the Chicago River, nestled between Gordon Tech High School and Lane Tech High School. The trail goes through Clark (Richard) Playlot Park, where there is a boat house that offers canoe and kayak rentals. After passing through this park, it continues along an impressive wooden boardwalk with scenic views of the surrounding city. This bridge crosses the river and then continues northbound until reaching Horner Park, a huge park with a natural area, sports fields, playgrounds and more.

There is public transportation via 77 Belmont, 152 Addison or 49 Western buses. Street parking is limited.



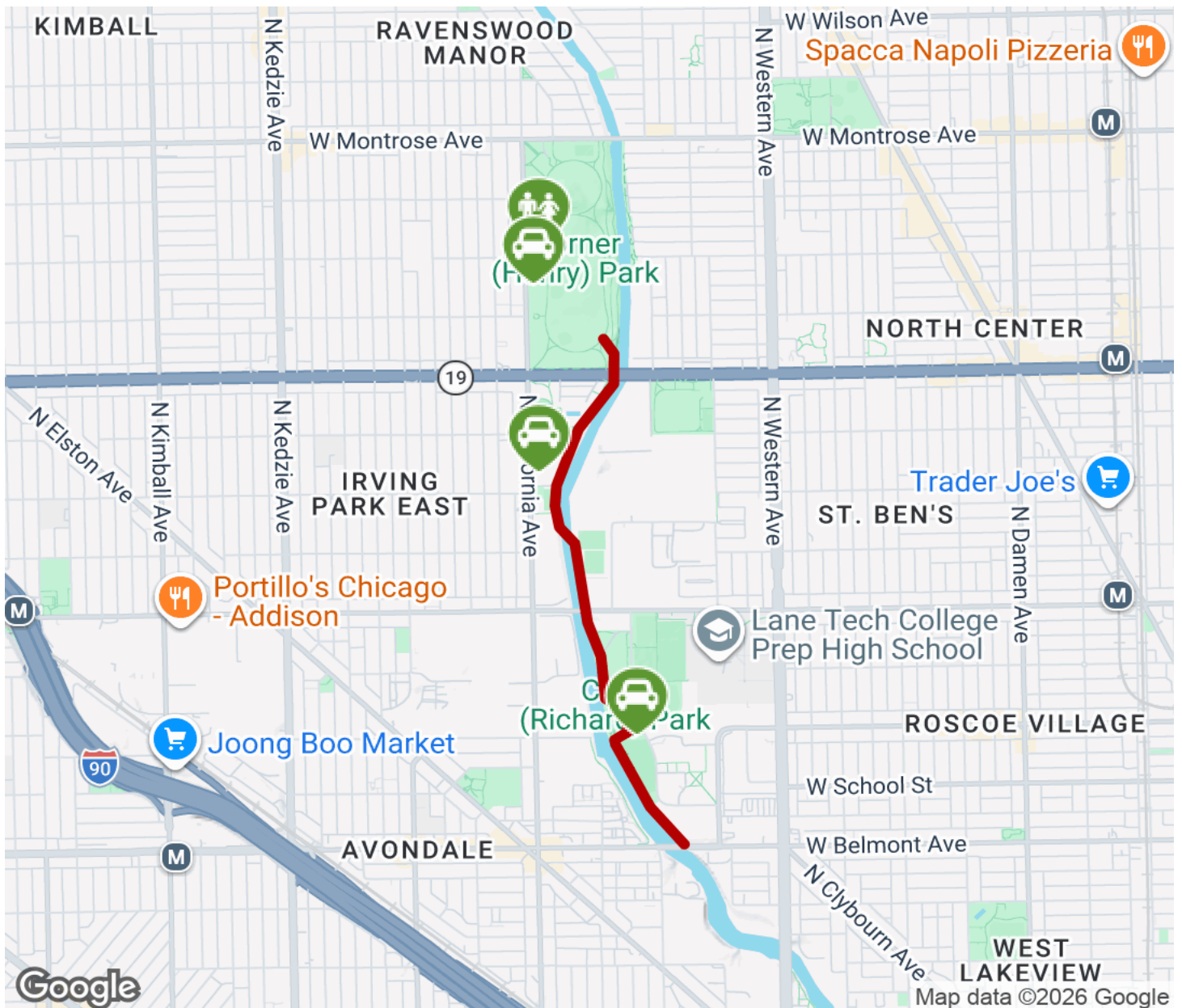
