Inside of Lee's Summit's Community Park, the Legacy Park Trail is a family oriented destination with an abundance of activities available. Sitting on 692 acres, the park host many youth sports games, holds 3 shelters, a 22 acre lake, playgrounds, fishing dock, and more. The trail itself is part of a larger 38-mile planned loop that will one day connect Lee's Summit, Grandview, Kansas City, and other rural areas. This Greenway Trail System was developed by the Lee's Summit Parks and Recreation Department.

The trail circles the entire park, creating a 4-mile round trip. Within this loop are two sub-loops; the Picnic Trail Loop (0.53 miles) and the Lake Trail Loop (1.69 miles).
