Rock Hollow Trail

Missouri



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The Rock Hollow Trail offers a beautiful, wooded excursion in the City of Wildwood, just west of St. Louis. The paved 2.3-mile trail is built on what was once Lawler-Ford Road. A trailhead with parking is available at its northern end, adjacent to Ridge Meadows Elementary School, and the trail slopes downhill from there. More than a dozen wooden bridges can be found along the trail, as well as several benches to stop and enjoy the scenery.

The trail is part of the growing Great Rivers Greenway network and connects to the [Hamilton Carr Trail](#) and the [Al Foster Memorial Trail](#), which are also part of the system.

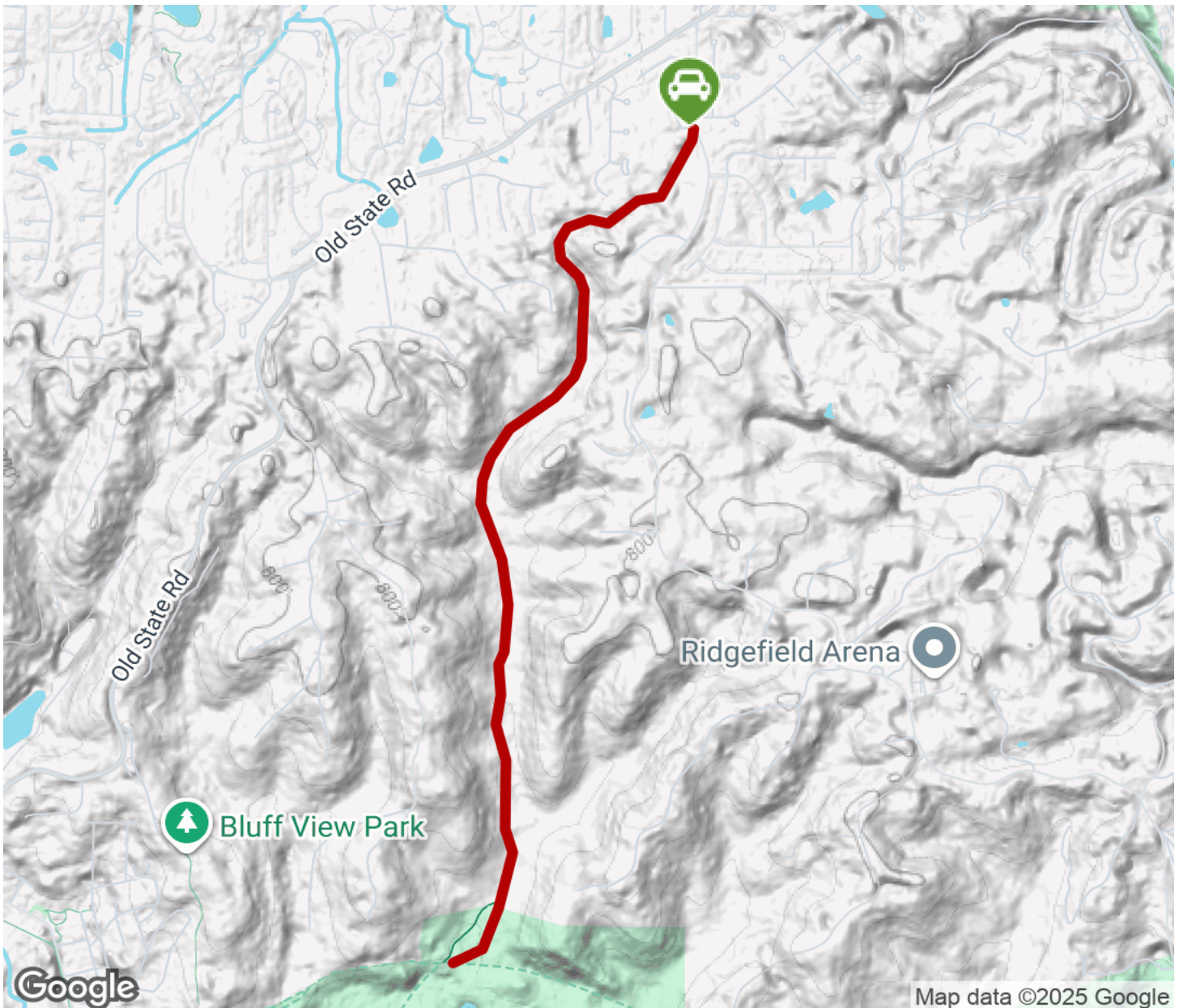
