The Harbor View Trail occupies a former rail bed—now shared with overhead electric transmission wires—on the southern edge of Lakeside Park in Fond du Lac. The trail parallels Harbor View Drive for its entire length. The park is a highlight of the route, offering more than 400 acres of recreational space (and a lighthouse!) on the scenic southern shore of Lake Winnebago.

In the east, trail users can continue across the Winnebago Drive Bridge to reach the much longer [Pebbles Trail](#), open on the same out-of-service rail corridor. The two trails are part of a network called the Fond du Lac Loop, which encircles the city and also includes the paved [Prairie Trail](#).

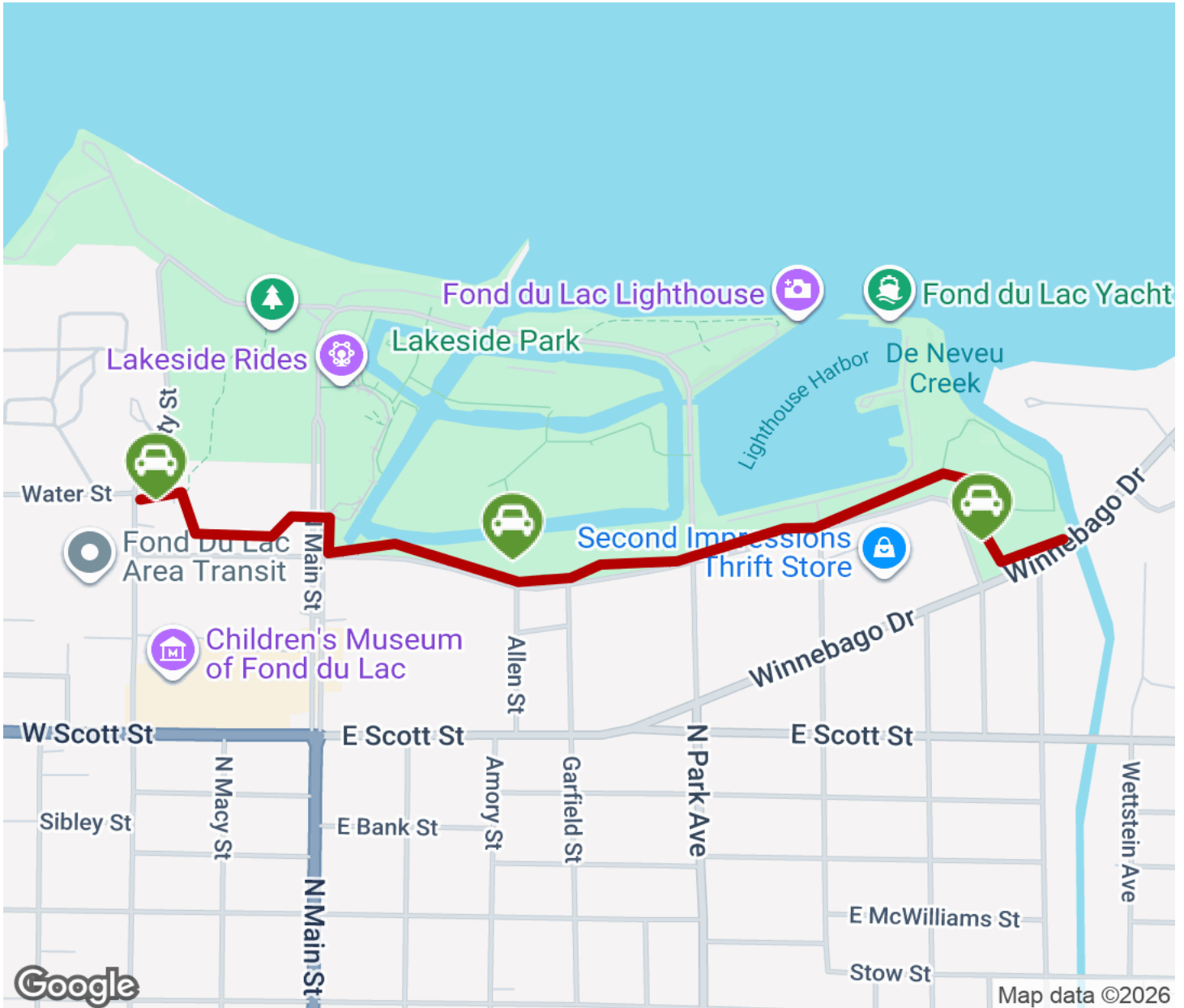
Parking & Trail Access
