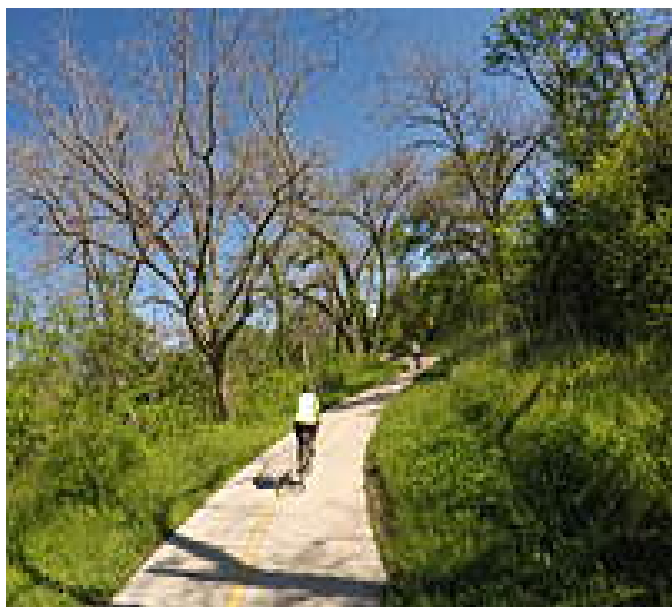

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About the Route

Following Walnut Creek, the paved trail travels mainly through forests as it traverses several parks. Various spurs connect it with the YMCA, Austin Tennis Center, and schools. The trail's north end terminates in the Daffan neighborhood, which once served as a stop on the Texas and New Orleans Railroad in the 1930s and 1940s.

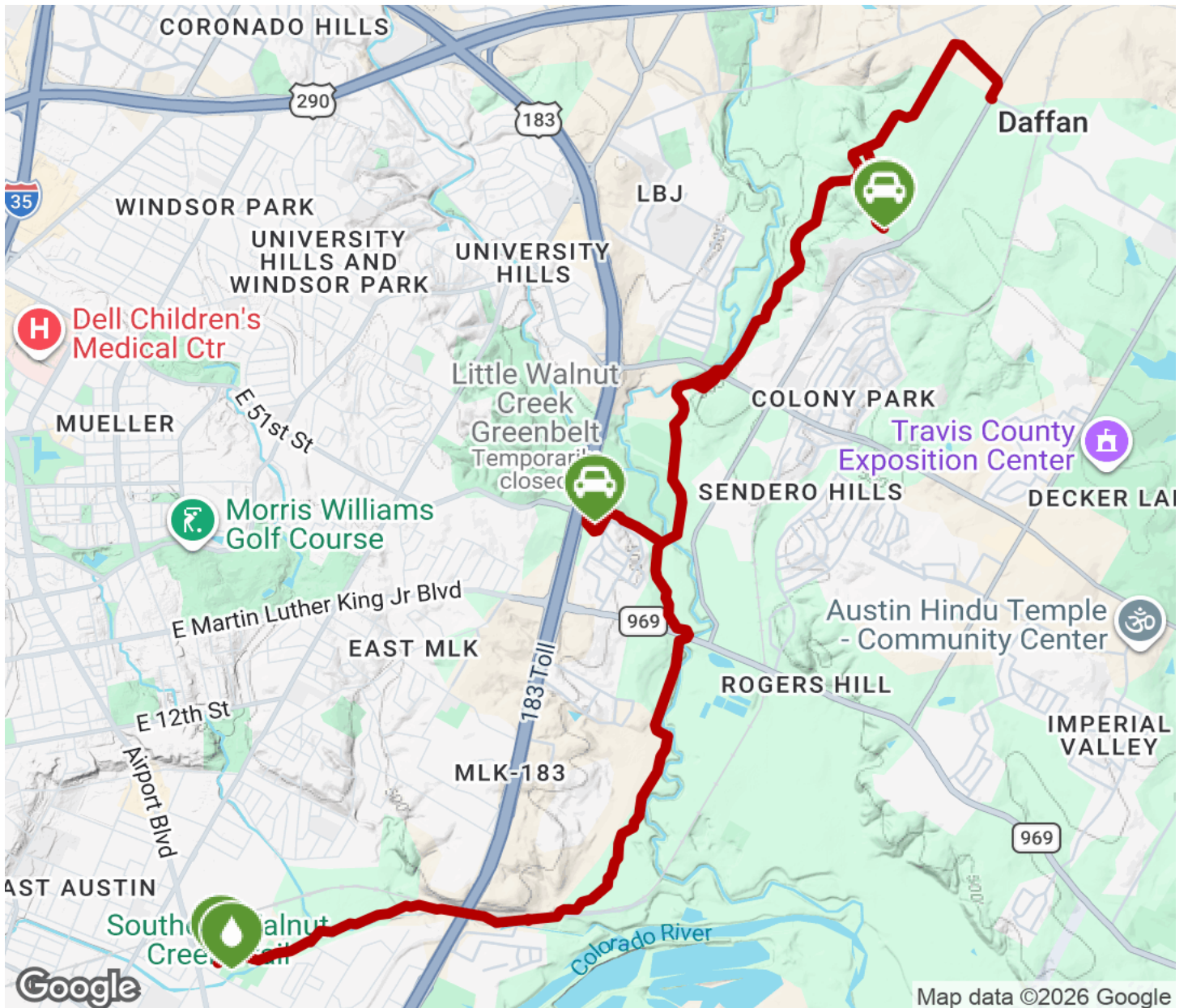
