[Regional Greenway](#), a 46-mile, primarily off-road, shared-use trail that extends from southeast Bella Vista to the southern edge of Fayetteville.

The Bella Vista Lake Trail forms a loop around Bella Vista Lake in the park of the same name, located along Bentonville's northern edge. Along with this popular paved fitness trail, the park contains a playground, disc golf course and picnic tables.

From the trail bridge over the creek that feeds the lake, the [Wishing Springs Trail](#) heads south, passing under Interstate 49 and linking to other trails in Bentonville's extensive network. At its northern endpoint, the trail connects with the [Blowing Springs Greenway](#). The three trails are the northernmost components of the [Razorback](#)


