The Cactus Wren Trail is a short connector between two much longer trails in Henderson: the [I-215 East Beltway Trail](#) in the north and the [Amargosa Trail](#) in the south. The wide, paved trail runs along an irrigation channel for its entire route, and a short spur near its midpoint provides access to residents of the neighborhoods along Ivanpah Drive.


