The Equestrian South Trail forms a crisscrossing loop around Equestrian Park South in Henderson. The park is so named



The Equestrian South Trail forms a crisscrossing loop around Equestrian Park South in Henderson. The park is so named because it offers a large area for horses and parking for horse trailers, but—despite its name—the trail itself does not permit equestrian use. To pursue their hobby, horseback riders should instead use the connecting [Equestrian North Trail](#), which is unpaved.

At the Equestrian South Trail's eastern end, the path seamlessly merges into the [River Mountains Loop Trail](#), a 35-mile route linking Henderson with the Lake Mead National Recreation Area, Hoover Dam and Boulder City.

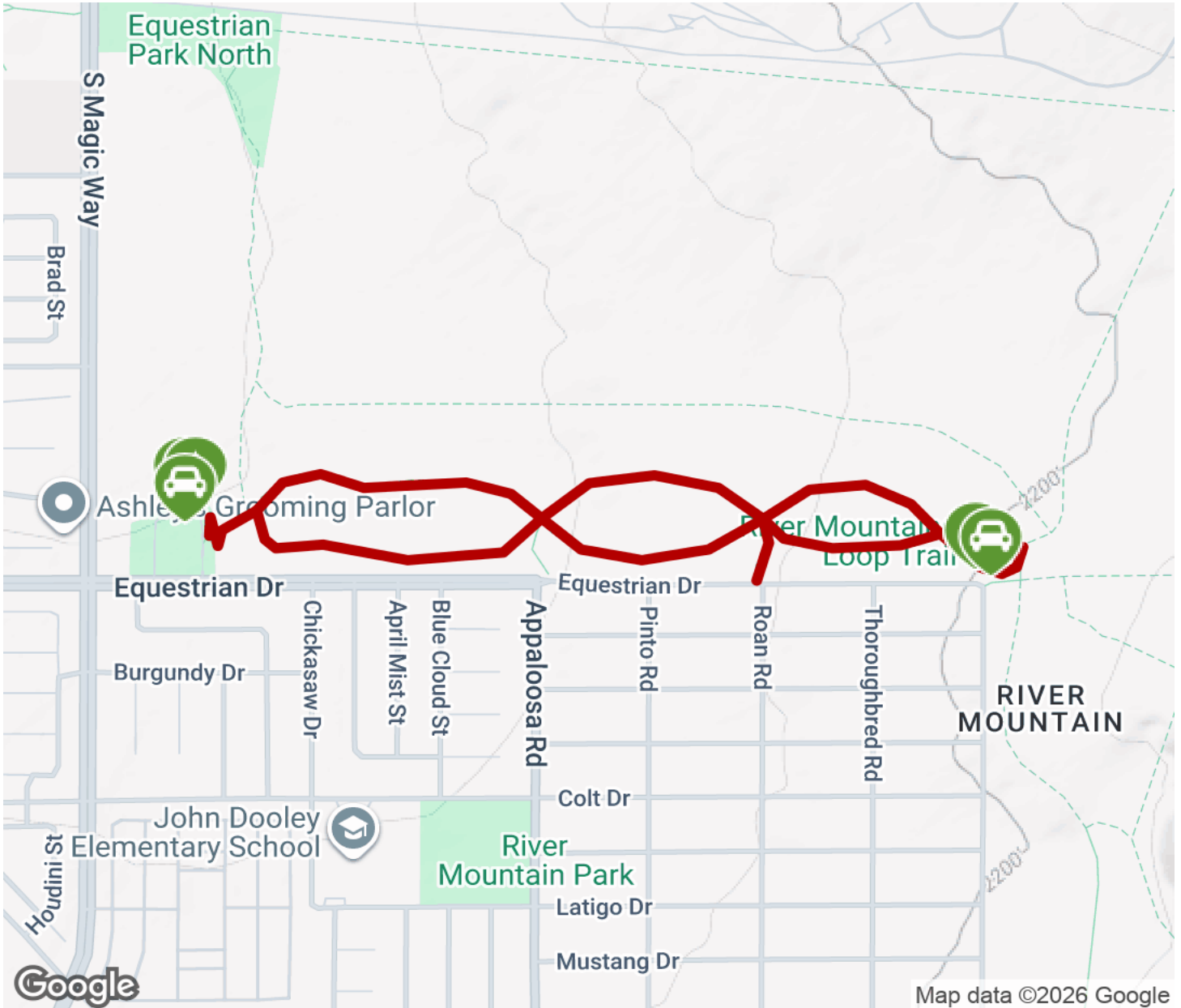
