Sawmill Bike Path (CA) California



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The Sawmill Bike Path currently consists of two open segments—with a third in the works to link them—just south of the resort town of South Lake Tahoe. When complete, the trail will provide a seamless route from the small community of Meyers to Lake Tahoe Boulevard.

The northernmost segment runs adjacent to Sawmill Road from Lake Tahoe Boulevard, where a connection to the Lake Tahoe Boulevard Bike Path can be made, to a point just east of Echo View Estates. The southern segment begins where State Route 89/US 50 crosses the Upper Truckee River and heads south to Meyers, passing the Lake Tahoe Golf Course on the way. At the trail's southern end, continue on the Pat Lowe Memorial Bike Path to reach a cluster of businesses along the highway in Meyers.
