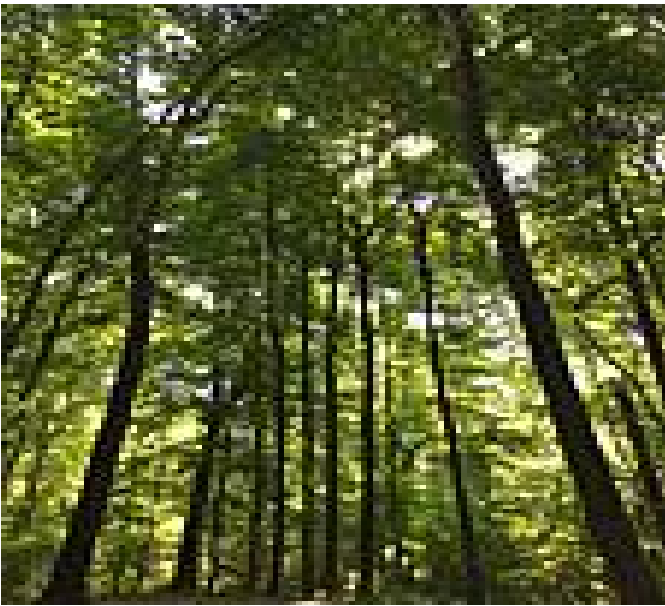

The Valhalla Trail runs for just over a mile in Delhi Charter Township, a southern suburb of Lansing. Its northern half is wooded and winds through Valhalla Park, which offers a swimming beach, playground, and picnic area. On the north side of E. Willoughby Road, the trail connects to the [Sycamore Trail](#), which continues north another 2 miles.

The southern half mile of the trail is nestled between Depot Street and Norfolk Southern Railroad. It ends at Holt Road, which trail-goers can follow west on a sidewalk into downtown Holt.

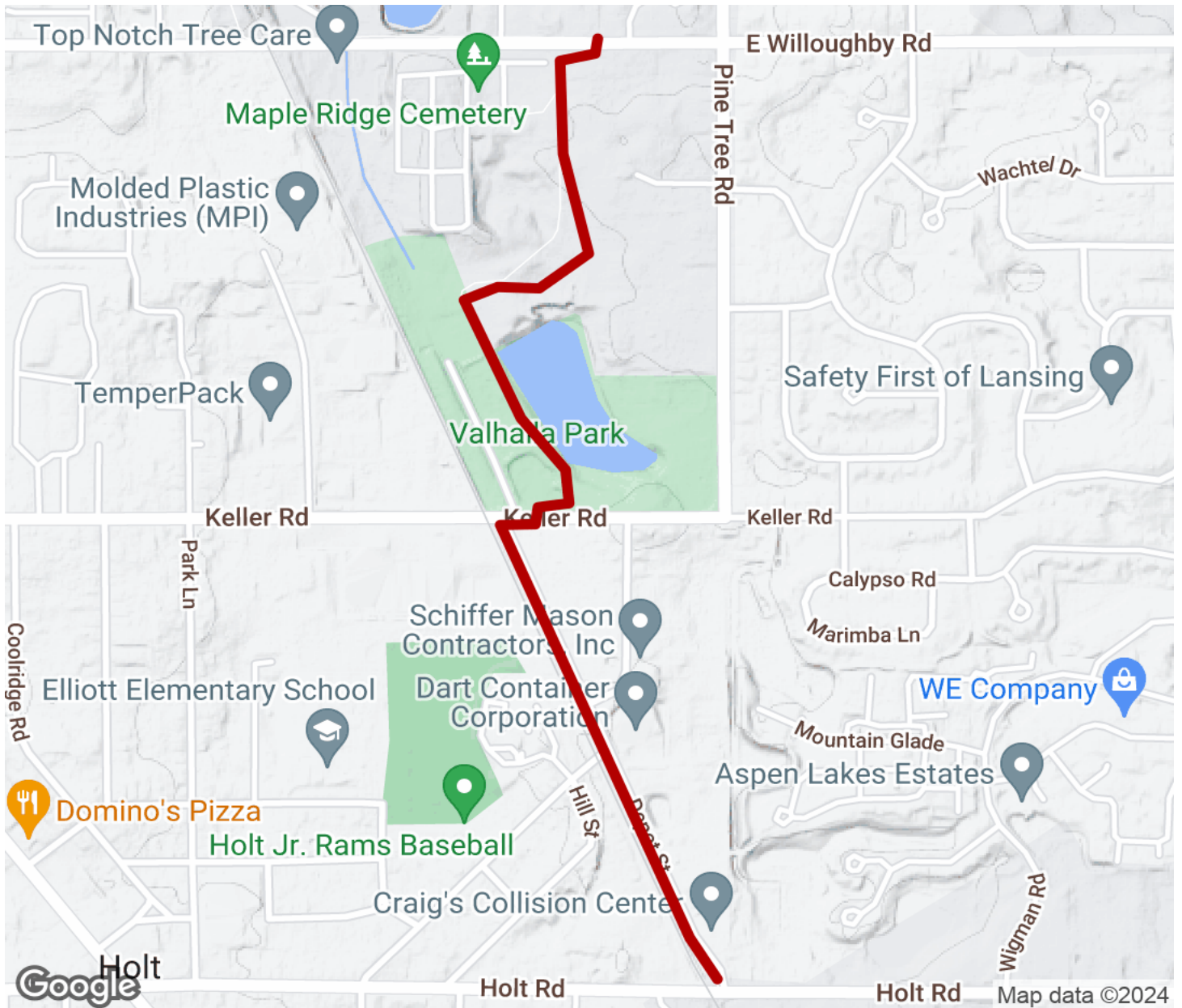
Parking & Trail Access
