Packerland Drive Trail

Wisconsin

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In western Green Bay, the Packerland Drive Trail primarily parallels its namesake roadway, just east of the airport. The paved trail is separated from traffic by a wide grassy median and has open, urban views. The trail provides access to several businesses along the way, including the Southwest Business Centre Park on its southern end.

About mid-trail on the east side of Packerland Drive, Hidden Valley Park with its arboretum, wooded walking paths, and picnic areas is worth a visit.

The Packerland Drive Trail runs 3.2 miles along Packerland Drive and together with the rest of the route in Green Bay makes up the West Main Loop totaling 6.9 miles.

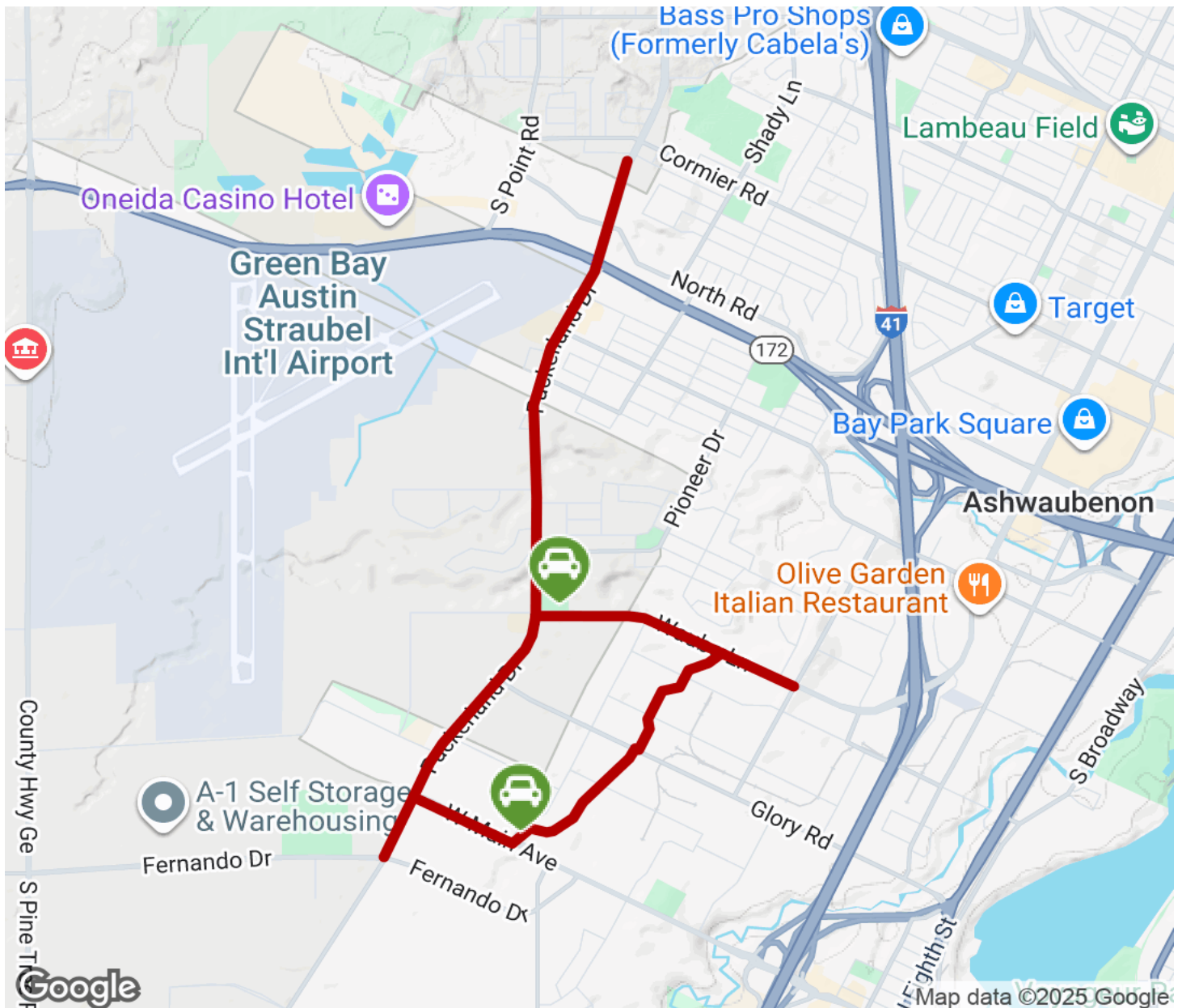
