The Pheasant Branch Creek Corridor Trail follows a lush wooded creek through Middleton, a northwestern suburb of Wisconsin's



The Pheasant Branch Creek Corridor Trail follows a lush wooded creek through Middleton, a northwestern suburb of Wisconsin's state capital.

Its east end is anchored by the beautiful Pheasant Branch Conservancy; one can cross to the north side of Century Avenue to hop on the [trail](#) that runs through the park. Mid-way, the Pheasant Branch Creek Trail also traverses Parisi Park, which offers tennis courts, baseball diamonds, and other athletic facilities.

The paved trail continues to [US Highway 12 Path](#), which heads northwest to Sauk City.


Parking & Trail Access
