Shanda Dixon Trail

Nebraska



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The Shanda Dixon Trail borders a residential area along Fremont Street in northeastern Lincoln and makes its way east to Mahoney Park. The trail circles the park, which offers athletic facilities and other amenities like water and restrooms.

Just a few blocks north of the trail, a connection can be made to the <u>Murdock Trail</u>, a rail-trail that stretches eastwest for nearly 5 miles. And, in Mahoney Park, you can also connect to the <u>84th Street Trail</u> that runs north-south.
