Roper Park Trail provides an oblong loop around a creek in northwestern Lincoln. The narrow, paved pathway (located west of I-180) traverses a wide, grassy area dotted with trees. Short spurs along the way provide easy access to the trail for the surrounding neighborhoods. On its northern end, the trail also connects to the <a href="Superior Street Trail">Superior Street Trail</a>, which heads east for about 4 miles.
