Short spurs along the way provide easy access to the trail for the surrounding neighborhoods. On its northern end, the trail also connects to the [Superior Street Trail](#), which heads east for about 4 miles.

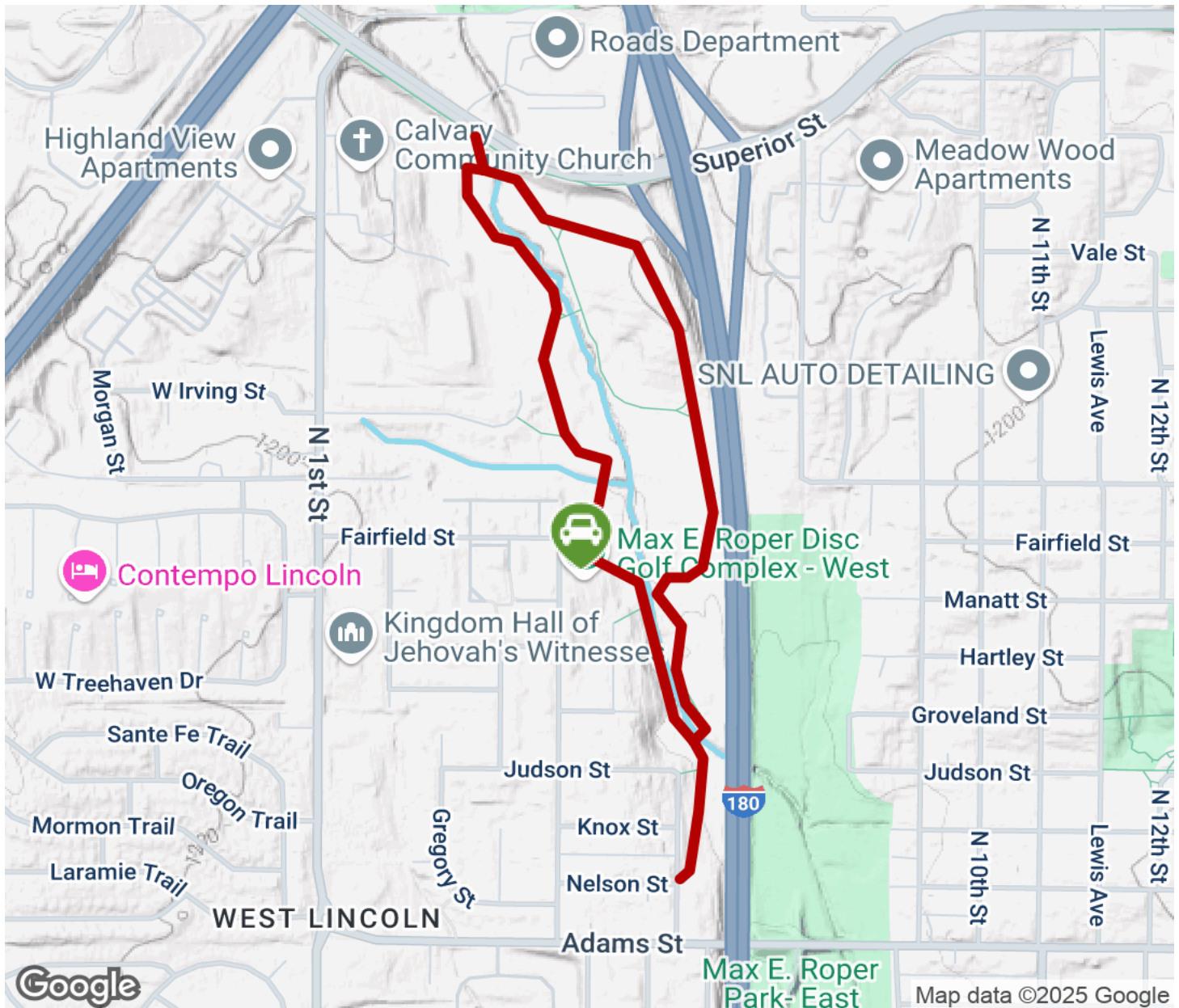
