Pigeon Creek Trail

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The Pigeon Creek Trail runs along an operating port terminal and users of the trail are protected from the secured industrial terminal by a fence, which runs along side the trail. You will occasionally catch trains going by but it is relatively safe. The trail has a great view of the public beach and access to wildlife at the western end of the path. Picnic tables are also available if you plan to spend a leisurely day at the beach. The area is open dusk til dawn and all pedestrians must abide the posted signs.

The Pigeon Creek Trail connects to the Mill Town Trail, a historic tour of the industrial Everett waterfront.

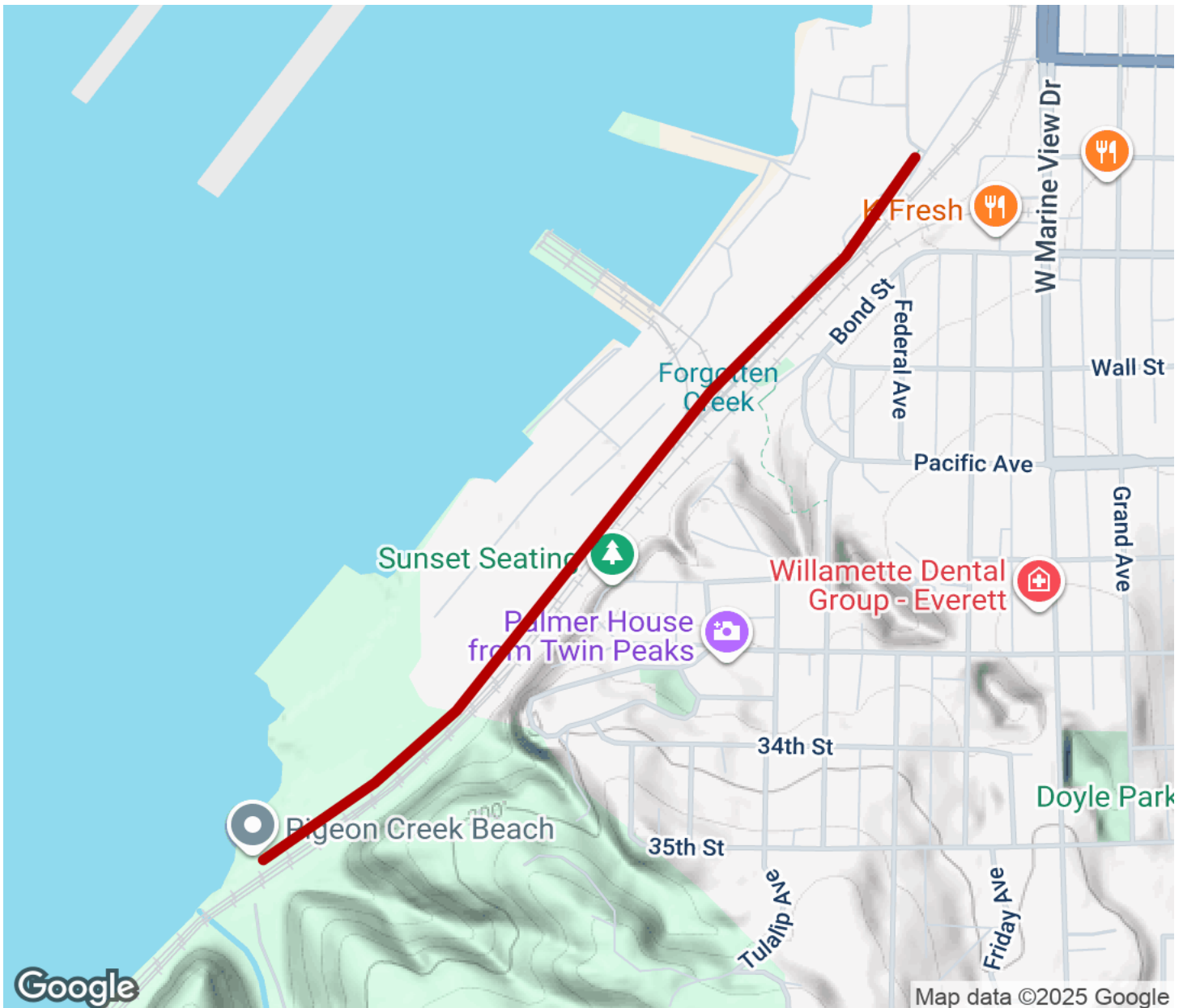
Parking & Trail Access
