Overview Running along the shore of a barrier island, the Lake Trail offers views of the mainland across the gorgeous blue water.



Nicknamed the Trail of Conspicuous Consumption, you can get some good looks at the beautiful mansions in this upscale area. A water fountain is available at the northern end, but it wouldn't hurt to bring some with you if heading south. This trail will not disappoint those looking for an easy-going and relaxing ride with a great view along the way.

Overview

Running along the shore of a barrier island, the Lake Trail offers views of the mainland across the gorgeous blue water. Located in Palm Beach, the 4.9-mile trail travels north to south along a paved path adjacent to Lake Worth and the boat docks.

About the Route

Most of the trail is off the main road, but there are some street crossings in the southern portion of the ride. Trees lining the route provide some shade and you can easily leave the trail to check out any of the nearby schools, shops, and restaurants.


