From Fritz Park on its northern end, the first half of the trail follows Cottonwood Creek through Creekside Park. Once you get to Meadowside Drive, the path veers west where you will ride on sidewalk pathways along Carl Stern Boulevard. The trail provides a convenient recreational connection between Hutto Elementary and Nadine Johnson Elementary, as well as Hutto High School. The trail is an effort by the city to connect more neighborhoods to parks and schools.

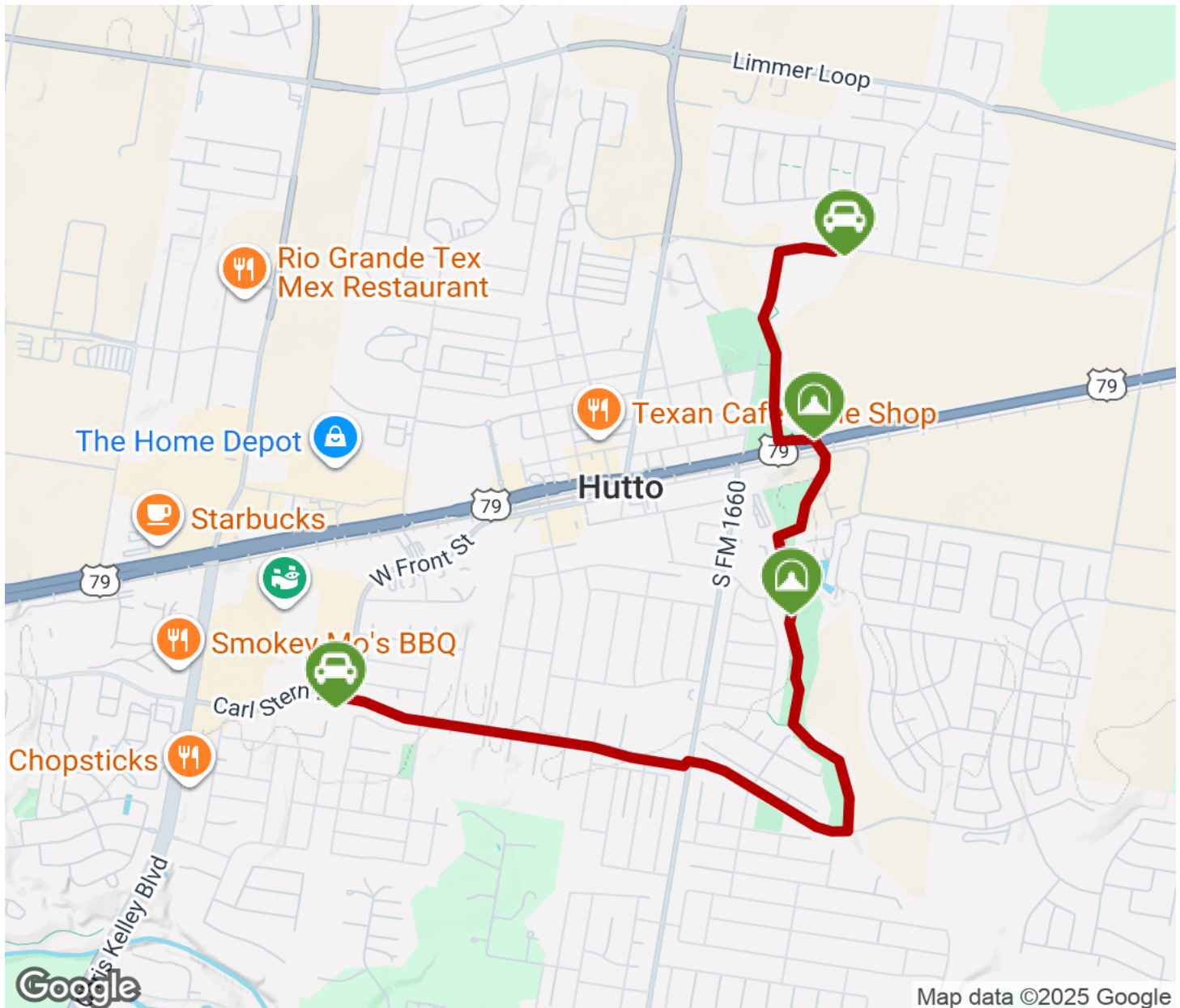
