Savin Rock Trail

Connecticut



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The Savin Rock Trail offers just over a mile of paved pathway along West Haven's coastline. Along the way, you'll enjoy picturesque views of Long Island Sound and access to its sandy beaches. The west end of the trail is anchored by historical Bradley Point Park, where British troops invaded in 1779.

The trail is also part of the East Coast Greenway, an expansive trail system that will span 2,900 miles along the Eastern Seaboard.

Parking and restrooms can be found on the trail's west end in Bradley Point Park, though note that there's a parking fee.



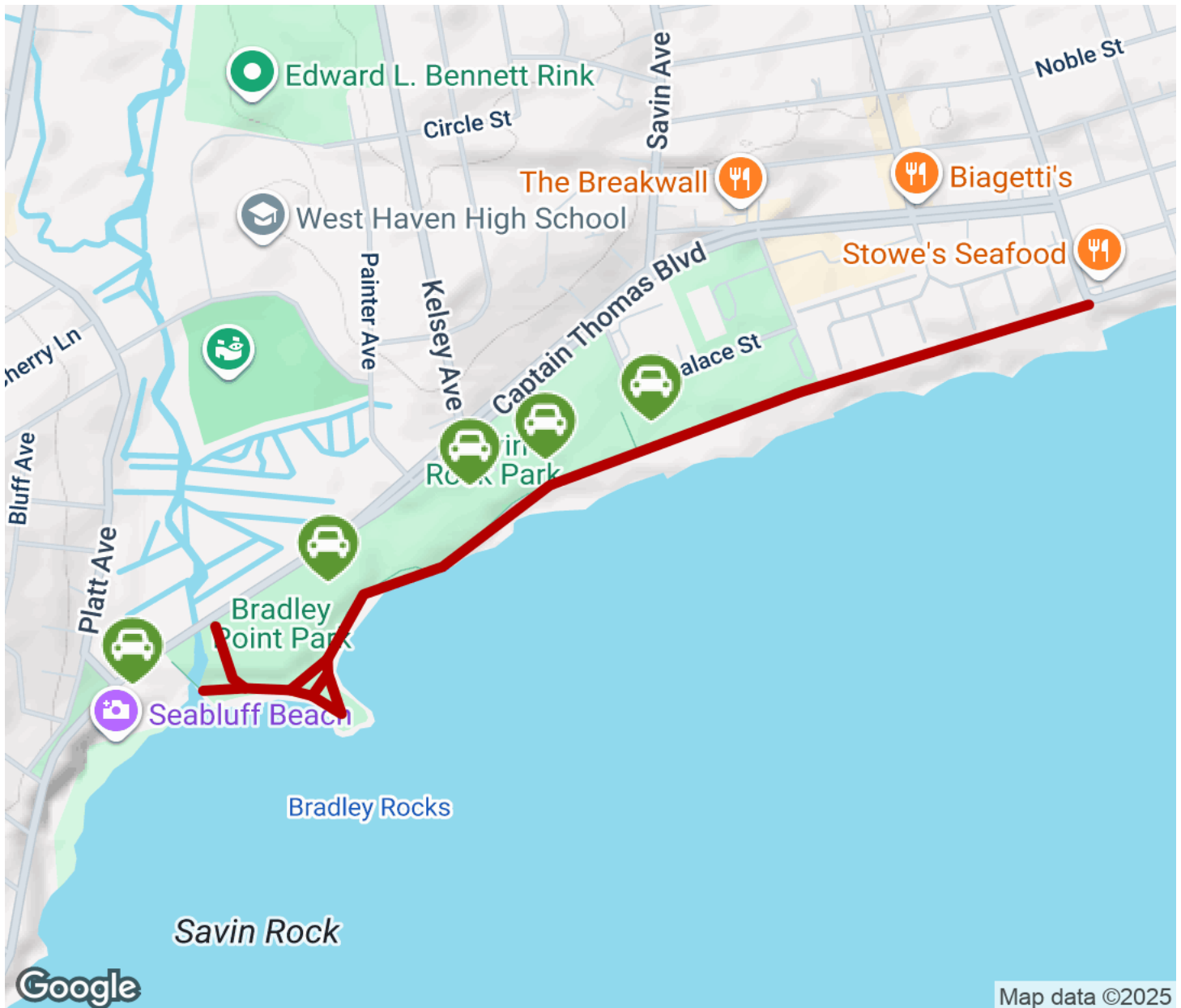
