The Fred Thwaites Grand River Trail, also known as the Ionia River Trail, travels for just over 3 miles along the edge of Grand River.



The Fred Thwaites Grand River Trail, also known as the Ionia River Trail, travels for just over 3 miles along the edge of Grand River. The paved pathway begins at Quarry Road and travels to the Ionia County Fairgrounds. Much of the tree-lined route follows a former rail line that once connected Ionia and Lansing. A restored railroad bridge offers views of the river.

Just a few blocks north of and parallel to the trail is the [Fred Meijer Grand River Valley Trail](#), which connects Ionia to Lowell.

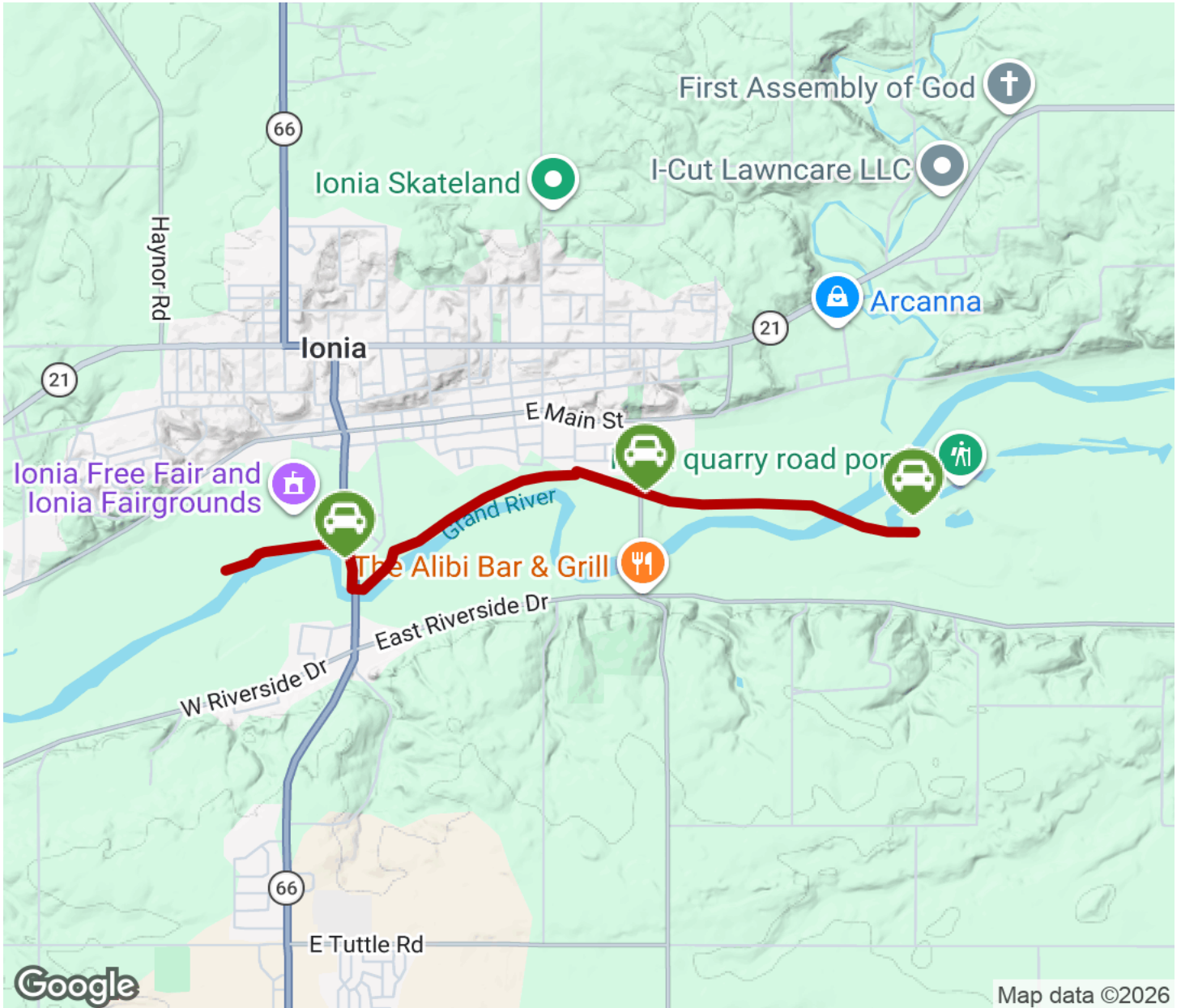
Parking & Trail Access
