

Hiatus Road Greenway Florida



The Hiatus Road Greenway, which parallels the C-42 Canal, consists of just over 5 miles of multipurpose paved pathway



The Hiatus Road Greenway, which parallels the C-42 Canal, consists of just over 5 miles of multipurpose paved pathway between the cities of Sunrise and Plantation. The trail includes landscaping, benches, and signage in a suburban area.

On its northern end, the trail begins at Welleby Park, where you'll find a playground, volleyball pit, and picnic pavilions. On its southern end, the trail connects to the New River Greenway (also known as the Plantation Canal Path).

Parking & Trail Access

On the trail's southern end, parking can be found at the Plaza at Davie shopping center. From the complex, head north via the Hiatus Road sidewalk to the New River Greenway, then west a few feet and you'll find the southern trailhead of the Hiatus Road Greenway.

On its northern end, parking can be found at Wellby Park (11100 NW 44 Street). From the lot, follow the park trail, which will lead to the northern trailhead of the Hiatus Road Greenway. Restrooms and water also can be found at Wellby Park
