About the Route

On its northern end, the trail begins at Welleby Park, where you'll find a playground, volleyball pit, and picnic pavilions. On its southern end, the trail connects to the [New River Greenway](#) (also known as the Plantation Canal Path). The trail includes landscaping, benches, and signage in a suburban area.

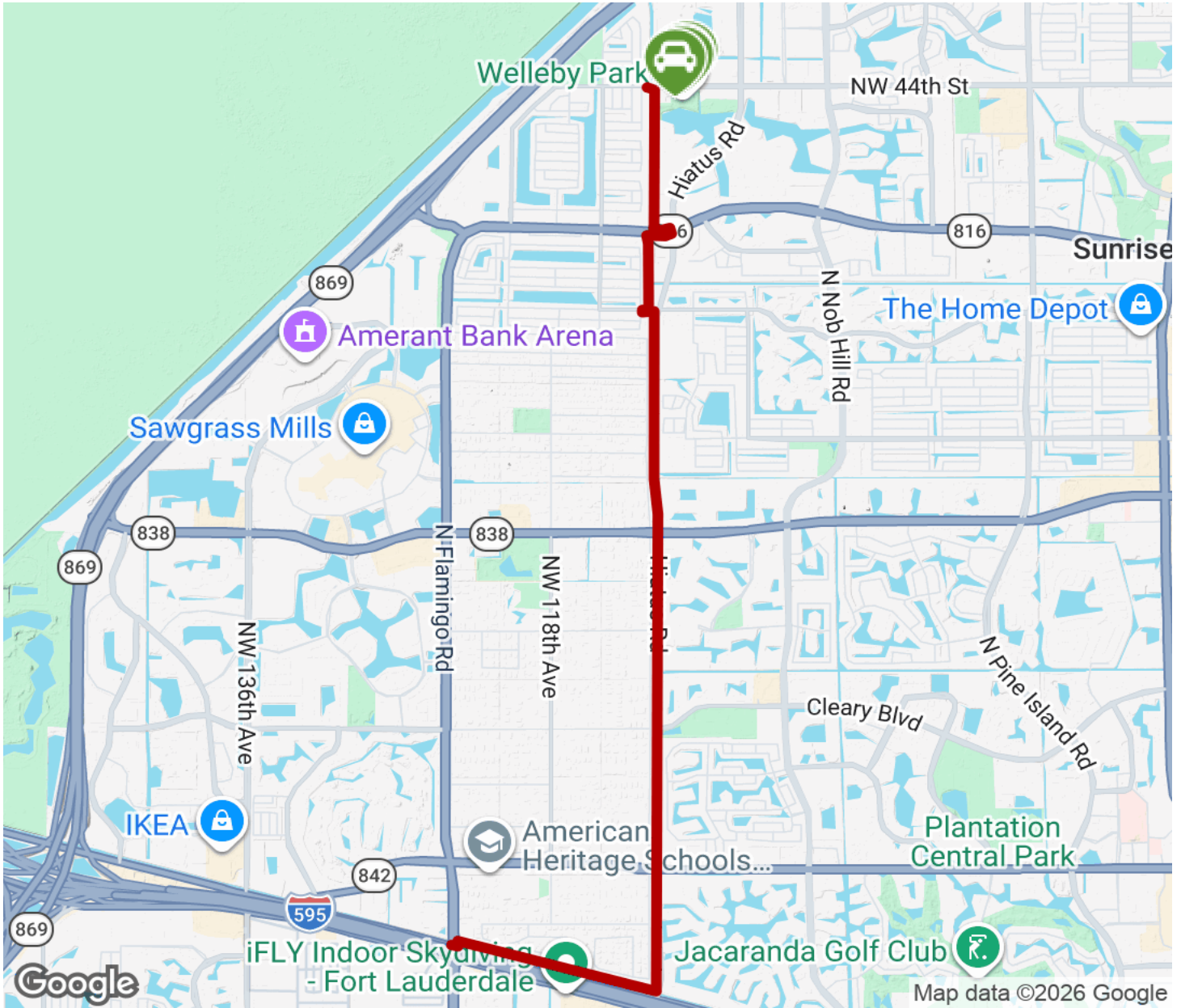
