Town Branch Trail (Fayetteville) Arkansas



Situated in south Fayetteville, the Town Branch Trail connects to the Frisco Trail on its eastern end and heads west to Greathouse



<u>Greenway</u>, a 46-mile, primarily off-road, shared-use trail that extends from southeast Bella Vista to the southern edge of Fayetteville.

Situated in south Fayetteville, the Town Branch Trail connects to the Frisco Trail on its eastern end and heads west to Greathouse Park, a 6-acre green space with picnic areas, a playground and basketball court. The paved pathway is largely wooded as it skirts around a busy shopping area and under US Business 71. At the western end, the Fayetteville's Town Branch Trail connects to the Cato Springs Trail.

A second disconnected stretch of the Town Branch Trail links S. Razorback Road (State Route 112) with the <u>Tsa La Gi Trail</u> at W. Best Way Street near Interstate 49, providing direct access to a number of student housing communities located along the two trails.

The trail is also a link in the Razorback Regional
