The Blue River Greenway winds along both banks of its namesake river on the southern outskirts of Kansas City. The paved route leaves off in the south from Minor Park and heads north, passing Alex George Lake and Blue River Park, before ending at E 95th Street. Another disconnected segment picks up in the north along E 63rd St. and also runs along the Blue River until Colorado Ave.

At its northern end, the trail connects to the [Indian Creek Bike/Hike Trail](#), which continues southwest from where the two trails meet (near the confluence of Indian Creek and the Blue River) for 26 miles to Olathe, Kansas.

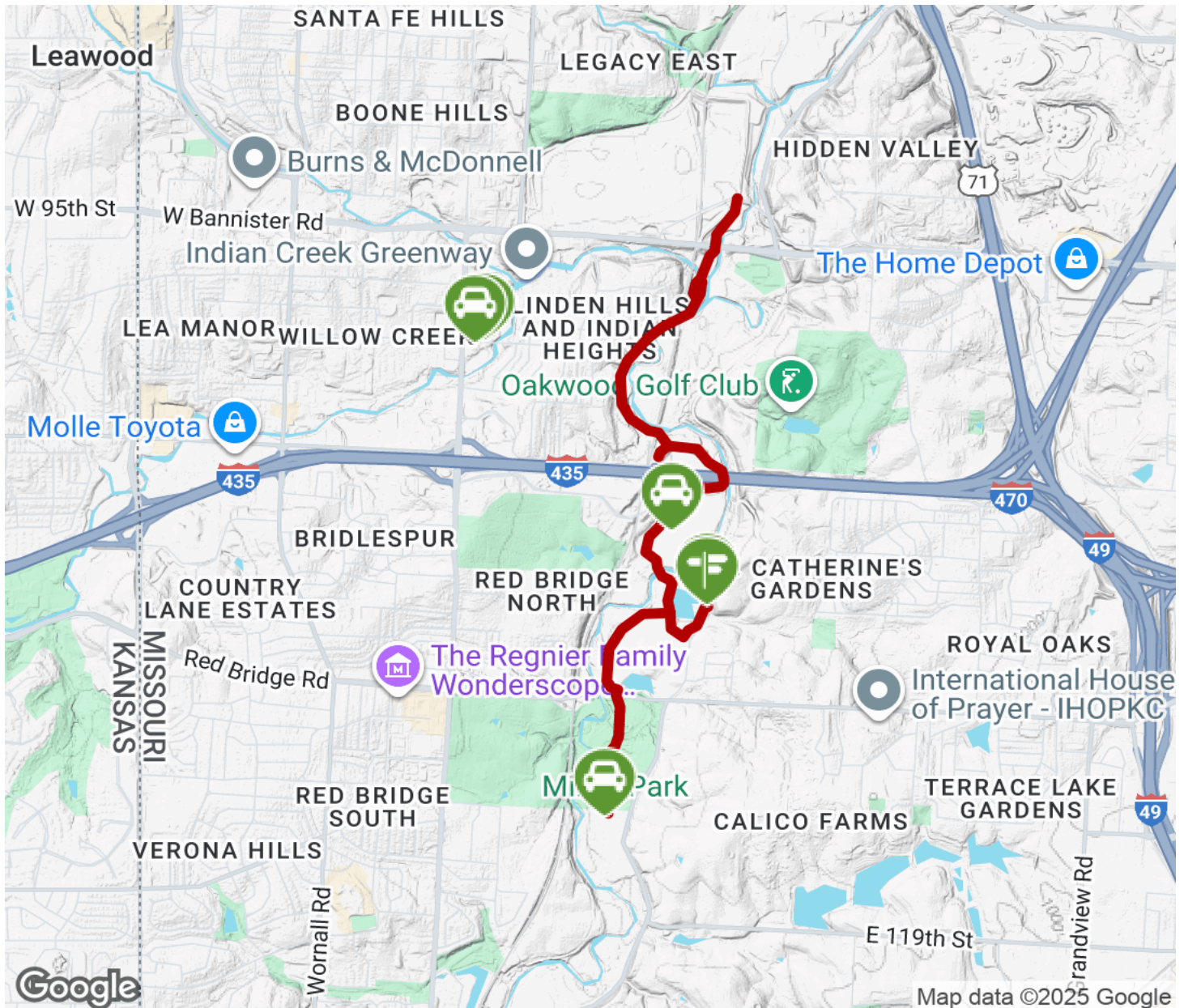
Parking & Trail Access
