The Blue River Parkway Trail winds along both banks of its namesake river on the southern outskirts of Kansas City. The paved



The Blue River Parkway Trail winds along both banks of its namesake river on the southern outskirts of Kansas City. The paved route begins in Minor Park and heads north, passing Alex George Lake and Blue River Park, before ending at E 95th Street.

At its northern end, the trail connects to the [Indian Creek Bike/Hike Trail](#), which continues southwest from where the two trails meet (near the confluence of Indian Creek and the Blue River) for 26 miles to Olathe, Kansas.

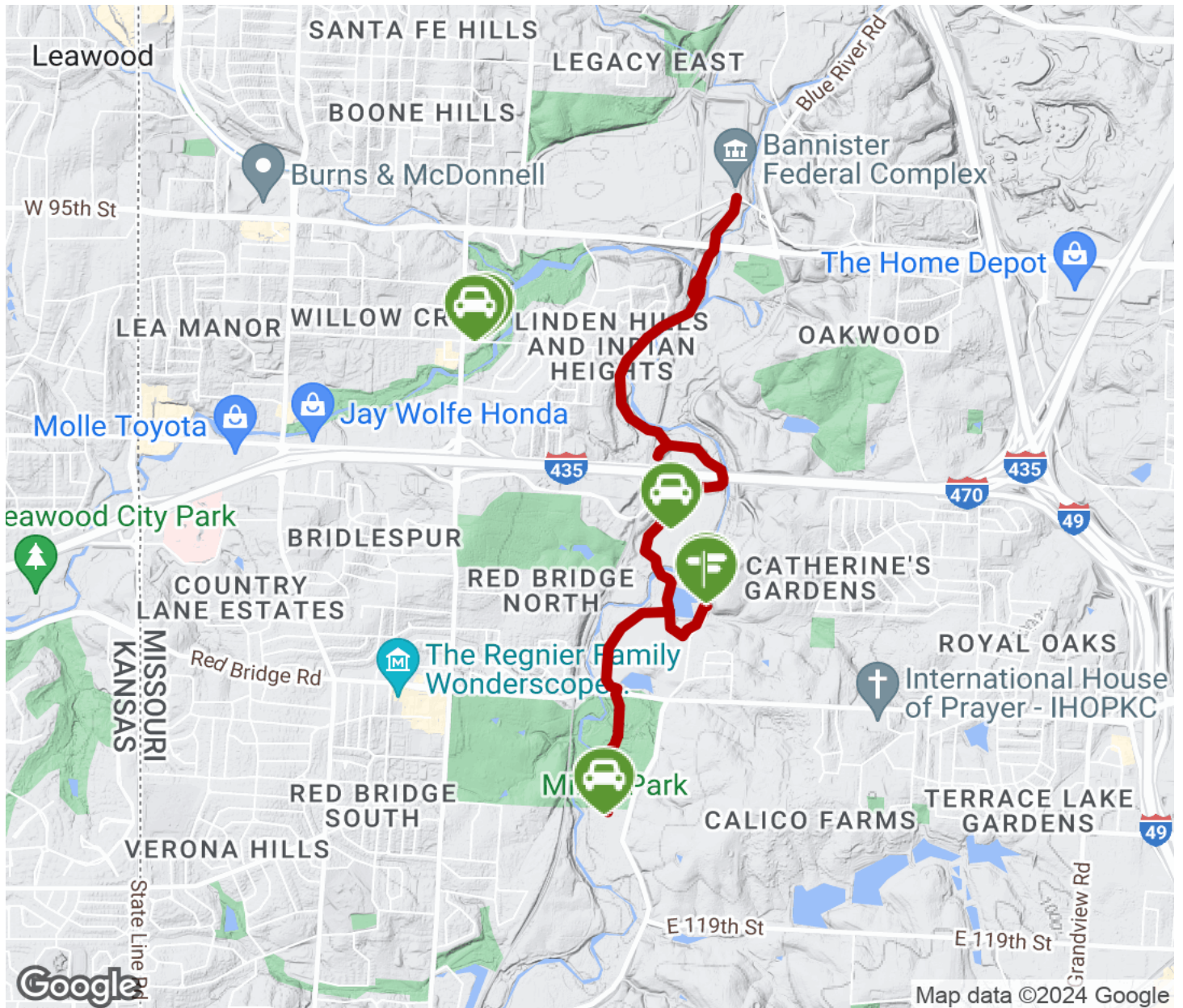
Parking & Trail Access
