The trail is also the perfect place for a family outing with large, shady oak trees and picnic pavilions, a playground, and easy access to restrooms.

At the southern end of the park, you can pick up the [Winfred H. Bonner Trail](#) by crossing the pedestrian bridge over San Gabriel River for an additional mile of walking or biking. Another option is to head west along the north bank of the river on the paved [Randy Morrow Trail](#).

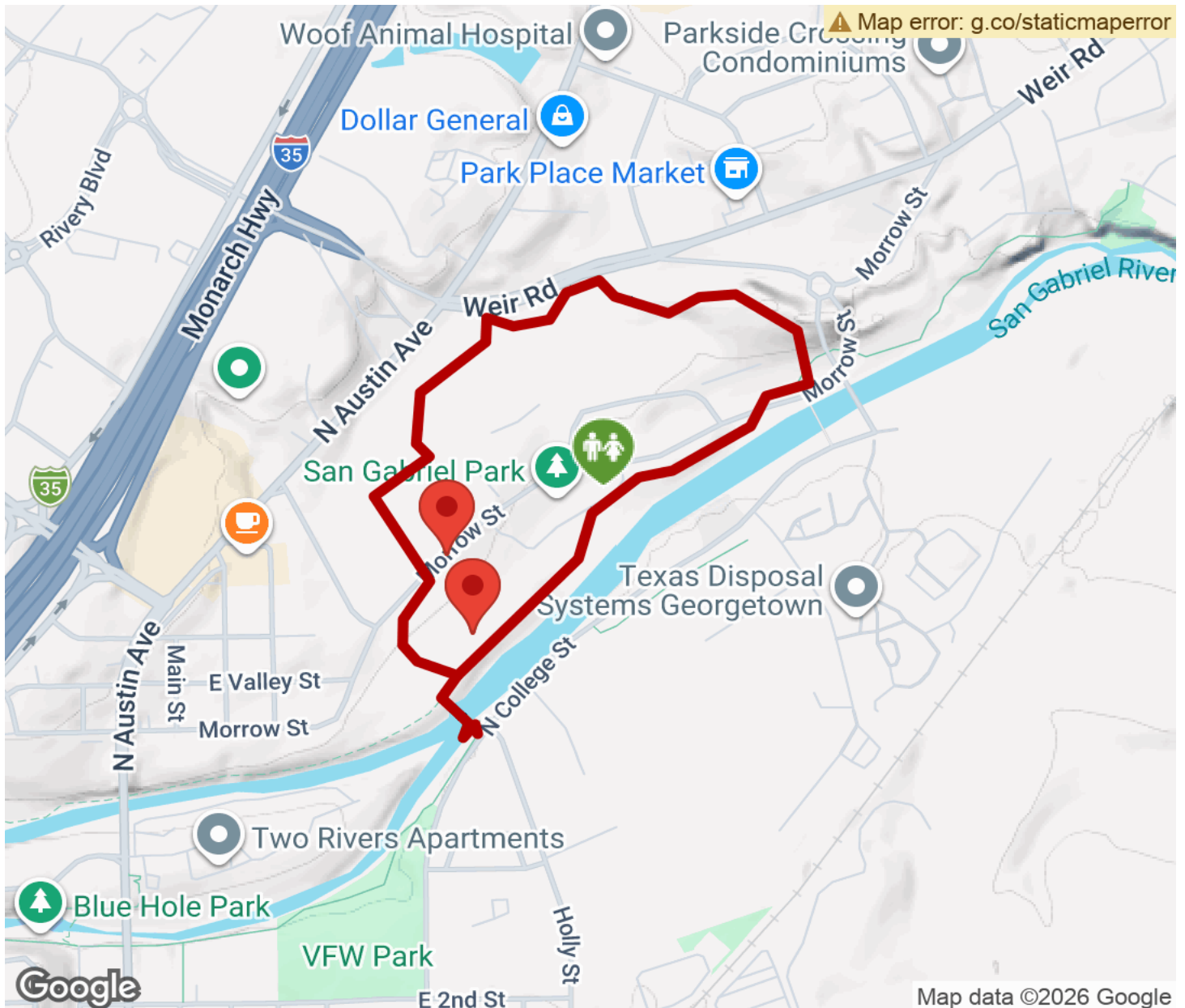
