Sandpoint Byway Trail Idaho



The Sandpoint Byway Trail offers an important north-south route through Sandpoint, a community on the shores of Lake Pend Oreille



The Sandpoint Byway Trail offers an important northsouth route through Sandpoint, a community on the shores of Lake Pend Oreille in northern Idaho. The paved 2.5-mile route offers pleasant views of the creek that it runs adjacent to and the surrounding mountains.

For more riding, two other trails are nearby: Pend d'Oreille Bay Trail and Long Bridge Trail. Just east of the southern end of the trail, you'll also find Sandpoint City Beach Park, which offers a beach, picnic tables, and other recreational amenities.
