Part of the township's ongoing efforts to create a network of multiuse greenways, Manheim Township's Heritage Trail begins at Valley Road and extends south, along the eastern boundary of Landis Woods to Delp Road.

The trail can best be accessed from a trailhead that features a paved parking lot and kiosk at its northern terminus off Valley Road. At its southern end on Delp Road, the trail connects to the Valleybrook Pathway. Continuing south, the pathway crosses Landis Run and adjacent wetlands to the Worthington Shopping Center and development off Oregon Pike (Route 272). The pathway features a boardwalk over the wetlands.
