The Park Street Trail is a short but critical link in Springdale's growing trail network. Running for just a few blocks along its namesake road, the trail links the utilitarian Powell Street Trail in the south with the more scenic Spring Creek Trail in the north.

All three trails are also components of the <u>Razorback</u> <u>Regional Greenway</u>, a 46-mile, primarily off-road, shareduse trail that extends from southeast Bella Vista to the southern edge of Fayetteville.
