The Park Street Trail is a short but critical link in Springdale's growing trail network. Running for just a few blocks along its namesake road, the trail links the utilitarian [Powell Street Trail](#) in the south with the more scenic [Spring Creek Trail](#) in the north.

All three trails are also components of the [Razorback Regional Greenway](#), a 46-mile, primarily off-road, shared-use trail that extends from southeast Bella Vista to the southern edge of Fayetteville.

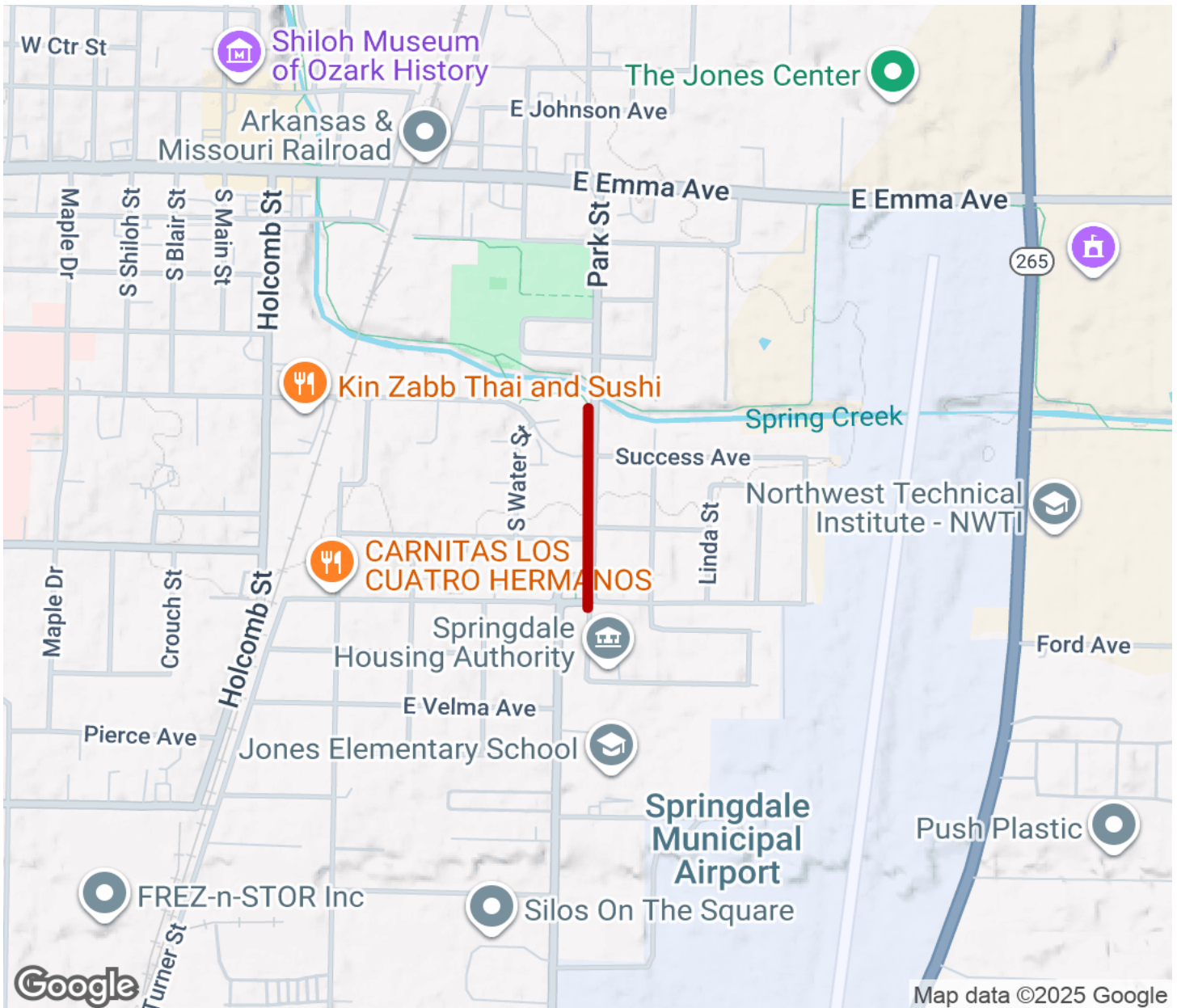
