Earth City Levee Trail

Missouri

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Earth City Levee Trail, which opened in June 2015, is part of a growing trail network called the Missouri River Greenway. It connects directly with the [Riverwoods Trail](#) in Bridgeton, forming a paved loop. Situated on top of a levee, the trail offers expansive views of the woodlands below.

The famed [Katy Trail](#) sits on the other bank of the Missouri River, in St. Charles county. Trail users can connect to the Katy Trail via the protected bike lane on SR 370.

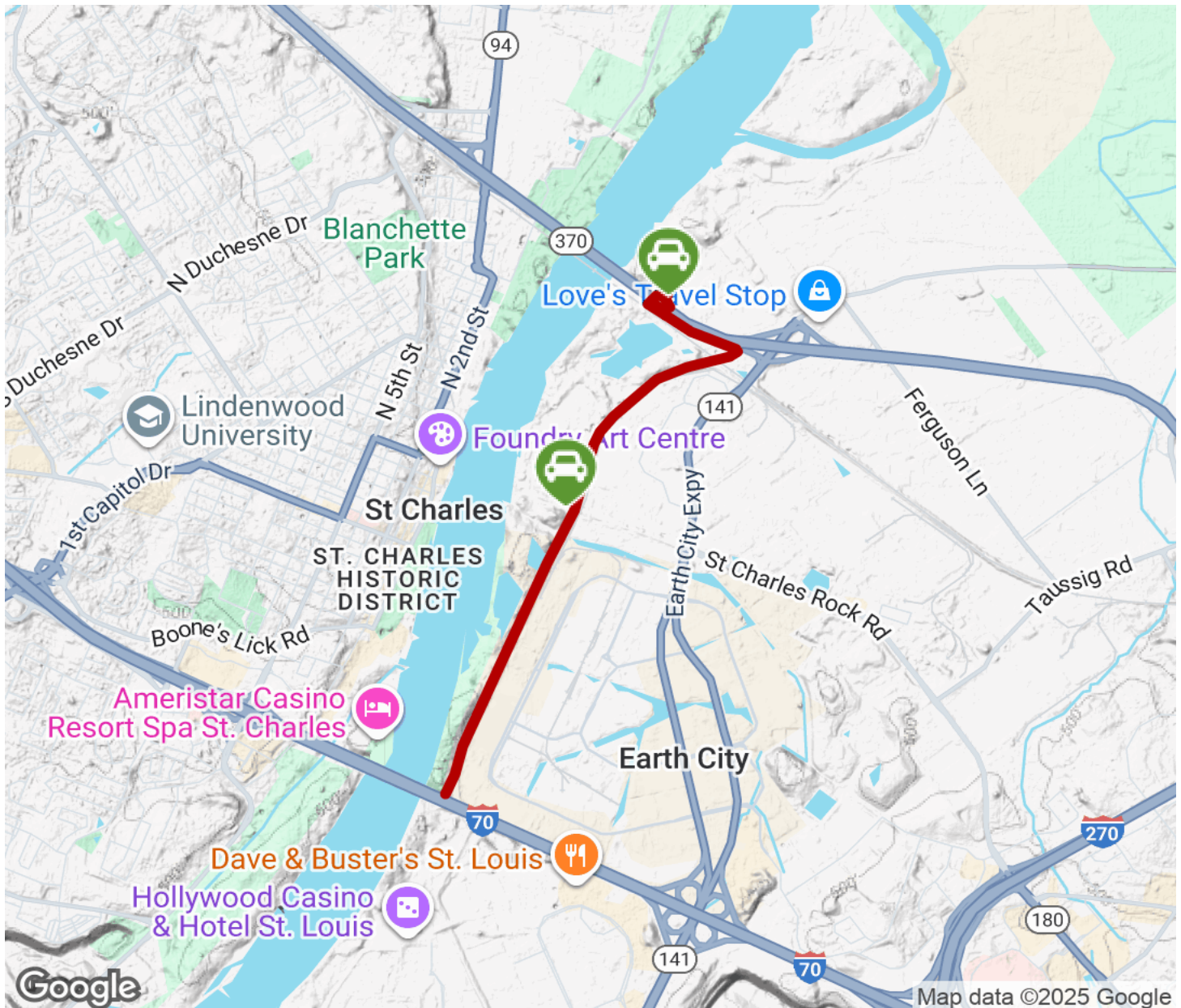
