Redwood Highway/San Clemente Drive Paths *California*



The Redwood Highway/San Clemente Drive Paths combine to parallel their connecting roadways on the edge of Corte Madera.



The Redwood Highway/San Clemente Drive Paths combine to parallel their connecting roadways on the edge of Corte Madera. The combined trail is more scenic than your average sidepath: to the east, views of the marshlands adjacent to the San Francisco Bay are framed by dry, rolling hills. In fact, the trail is part of the larger <u>San Francisco Bay Trail</u>, a developing effort to create a 500-mile multiuse trail encircling its namesake bay.

At the trail's northern end, pick up the <u>Sandra Marker</u> <u>Trail</u> (also known as the Wornum Pathway here) to reach the popular <u>NWP Railroad Trail</u>.


Parking & Trail Access
