The Great Highway Bike Path parallels its namesake road on the western edge of San Francisco, offering stunning views of the Pacific Ocean throughout. The trail provides direct access to the San Francisco Zoo at its southern end and Golden Gate Park at its northern end.

Periodic crosswalks allow you to reach Ocean Beach and the frigid Pacific Ocean. Alternatively, pick up the [Golden Gate Park Bike Path](#) at Lincoln Way to pass through the famous park and access its various landmarks.

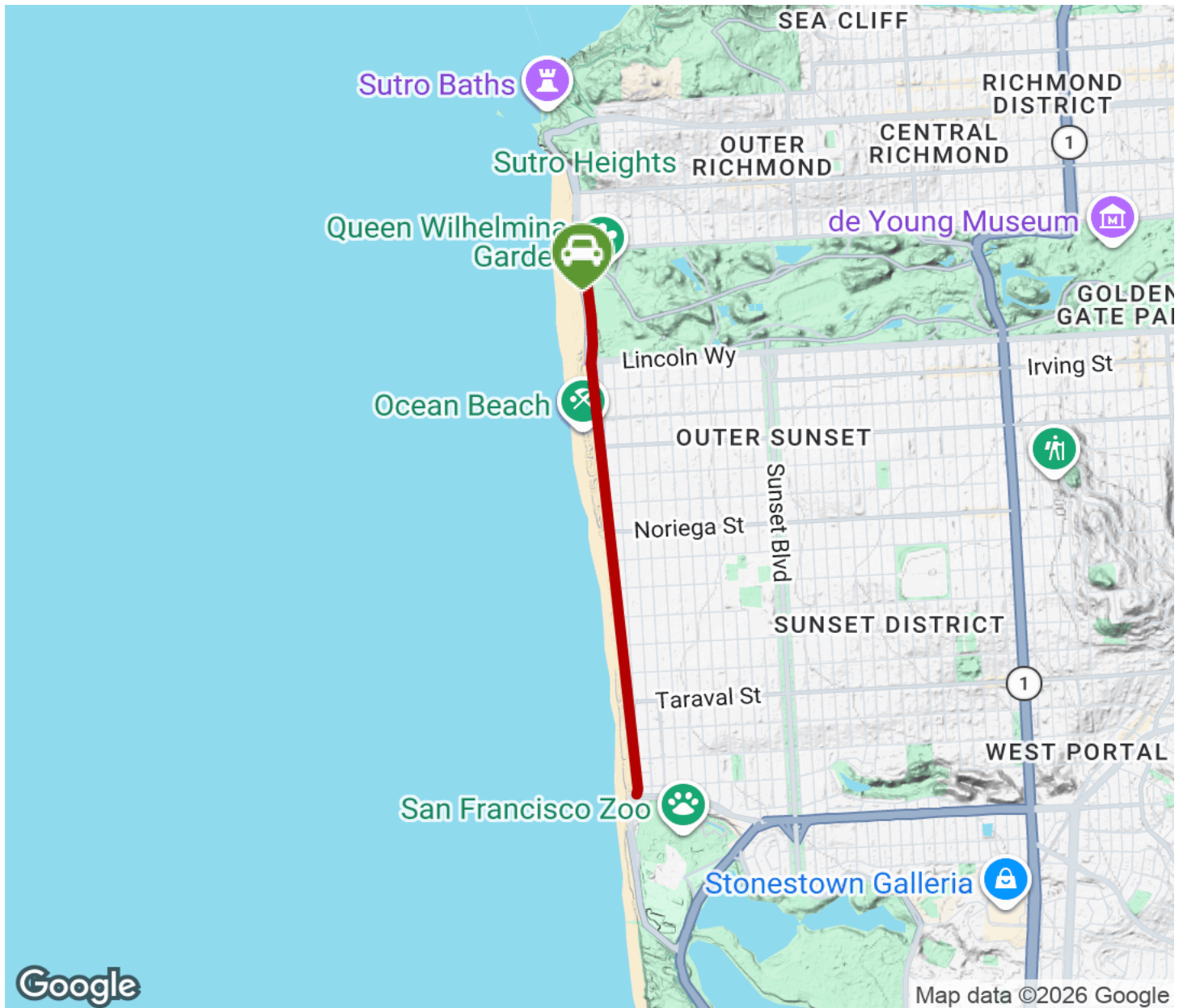
Parking & Trail Access
