Parking for the Mori Ridge Trail is available at a trailhead at the end of Mori Ridge Road, just off Cabrillo Highway (SR 1).



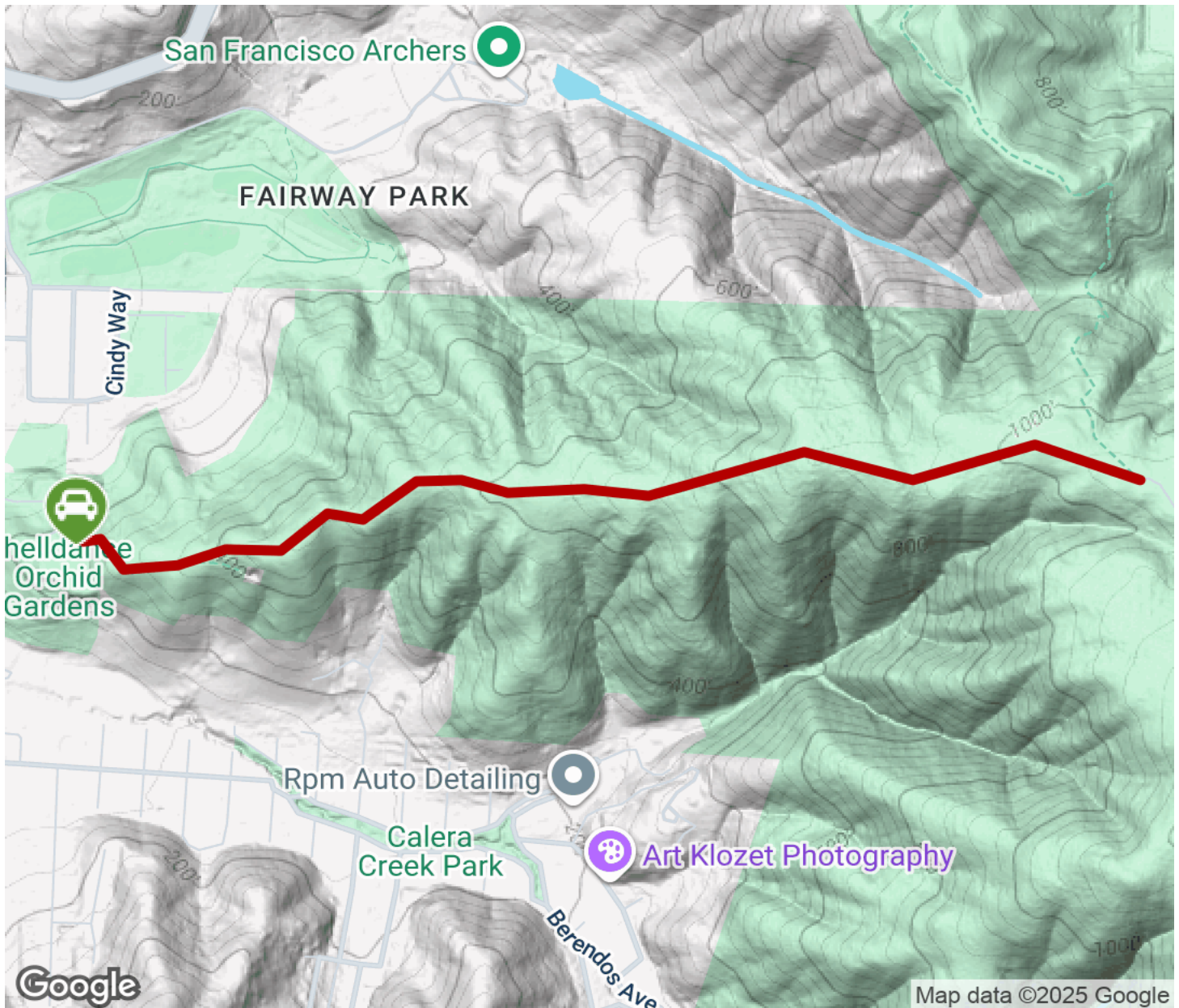
