Baquiano Trail

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The Baquiano Trail is one trail of many in beautiful Sweeney Ridge, a prime bicycling and hiking area in San Mateo County. The trail climbs 550 feet from a junction with two hiking trails in the west to the multiuse [Sweeney Ridge Trail](#) at the Portolá Discovery Site in the east. The monument marks the approximate location where a Spanish explorer discovered the San Francisco Bay in 1769.

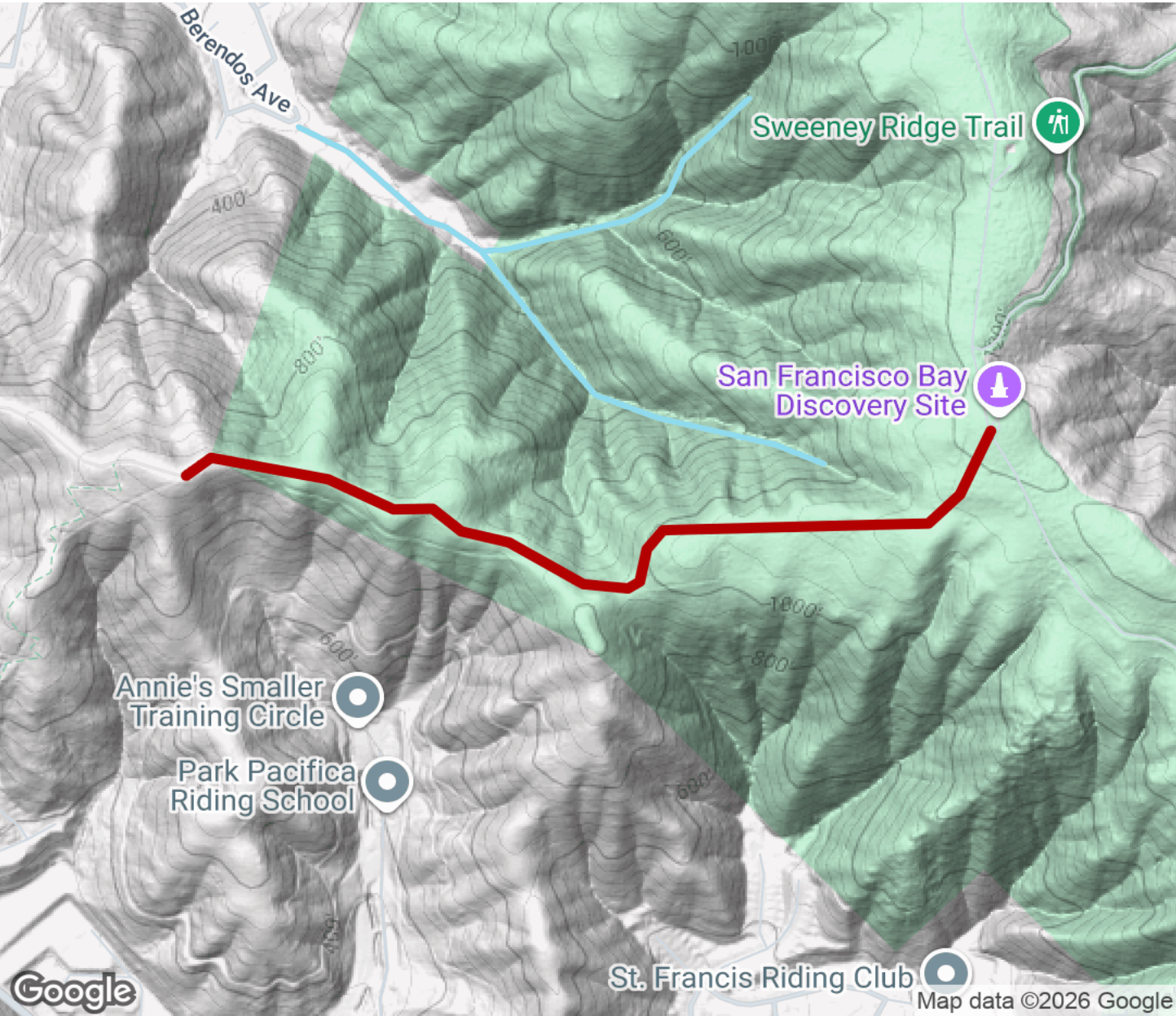
Parking & Trail Access
