The Palatka Urban Trail is a connector between the [Lake Butler-Palatka](#) section and the [Palatka-St. Augustine Trail](#). It was completed in 2013 and stretches about 2 miles. The western half of the trail on the former right-of-way of the Georgia Southern and Florida railroad whereas the eastern portion lies on a combination of off-road trails and on-road bike lanes.

Palatka's position as an emerging trail hub was recently recognized by the [Florida Office and Greenways and Trails](#). The city is now a designated Florida [Trail Town](#).

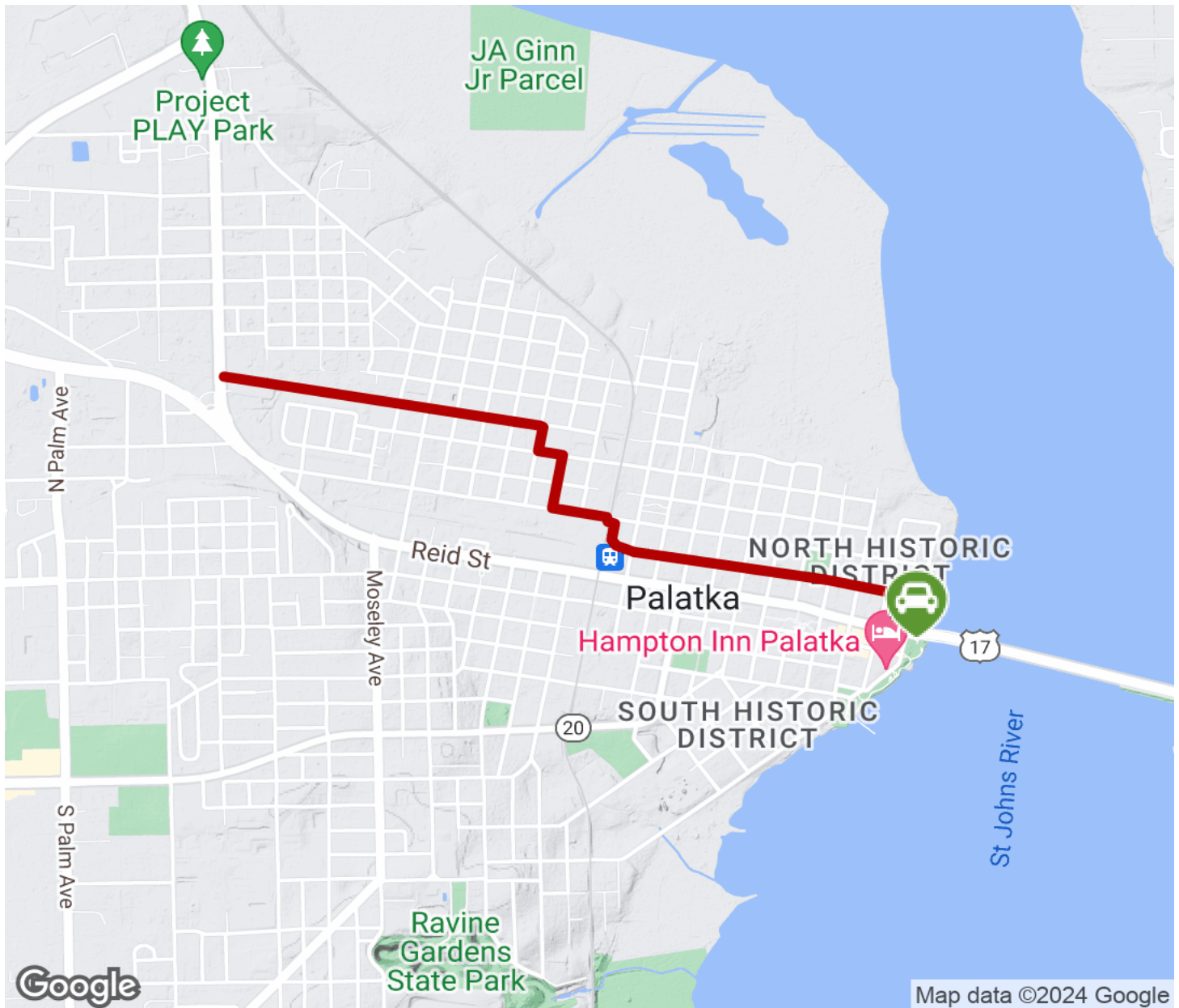
Parking & Trail Access
