Prince Memorial Greenway

California

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The Prince Memorial Greenway is a short urban trail on both sides of Santa Rosa Creek in the Sonoma County community of Santa Rosa. A major component of the city's efforts to clean up and restore the creek, the trail features native plants and up-close views of the historic buildings of Santa Rosa's charming downtown area.

From the western end at Pierson Street, trail users can continue on the [Santa Rosa Creek Trail](#) for a longer trip. Alternatively, head south on the [Joe Rodota Trail](#) via a trail bridge over Santa Rosa Creek near an active rail line to reach Sebastopol.

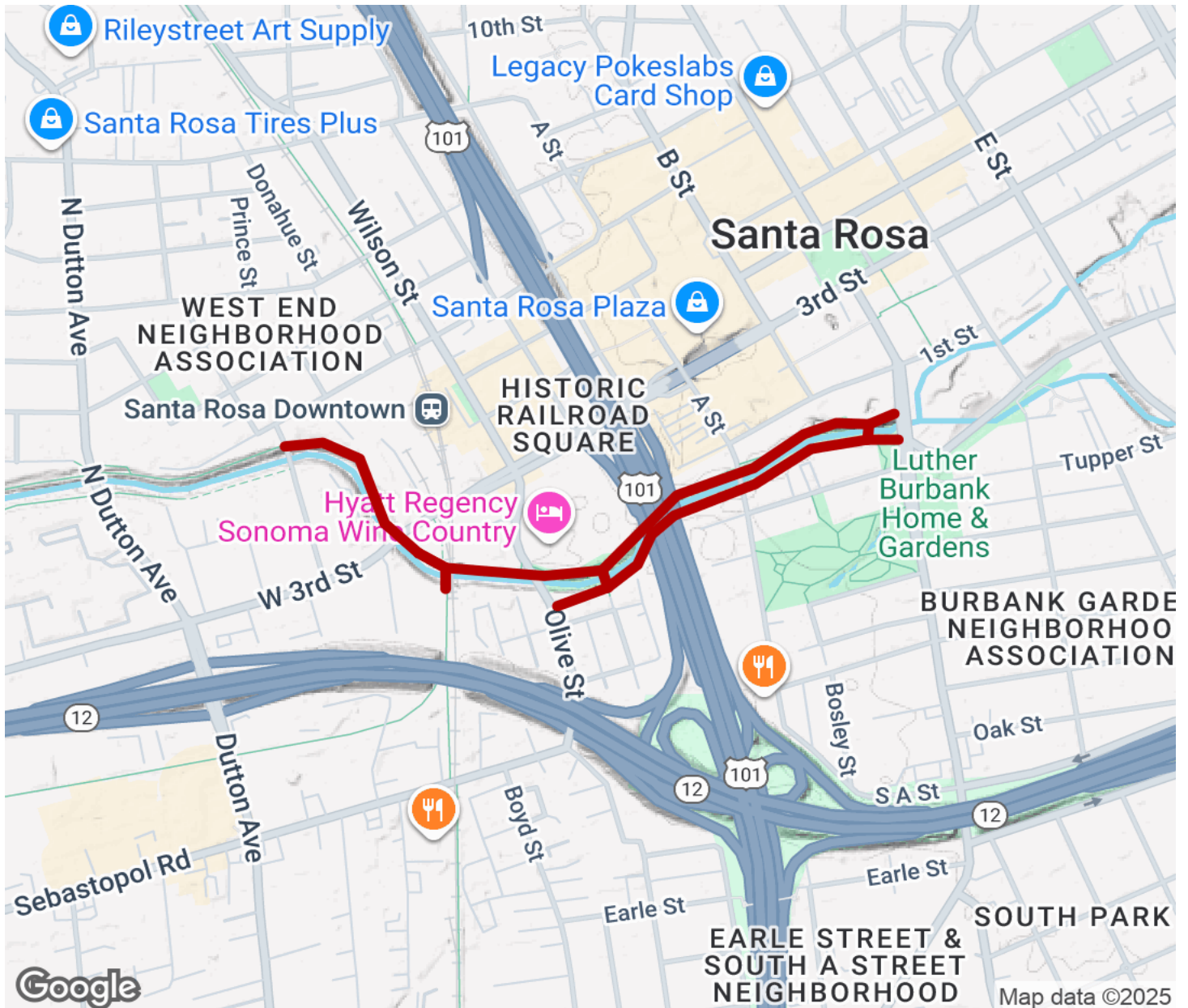
