The Elk Grove Creek Trail is open in two disconnected segments along its namesake waterway in the cities of Elk Grove and



is another popular destination along the main trail's alignment.

The Elk Grove Creek Trail is open in two disconnected segments along its namesake waterway in the cities of Elk Grove and Sacramento. Both portions offer a smooth paved surface and scenic views of the adjacent creek.

The southern segment courses through Elk Grove from Emerald Vista Drive to Lewis Stein Road and features a new, long trail bridge over busy State Route 99. Between Laguna Boulevard and Oneto Park, the trail runs on both sides of the creek, offering trail users a loop option.

The northern segment consists of several pieces that extend from Elk Grove into southern Sacramento, with the main route stretching from Bruceville Road to Franklin Boulevard. From Center Parkway, a spur leads east to Jacinto Creek Park, while North Laguna Creek Park

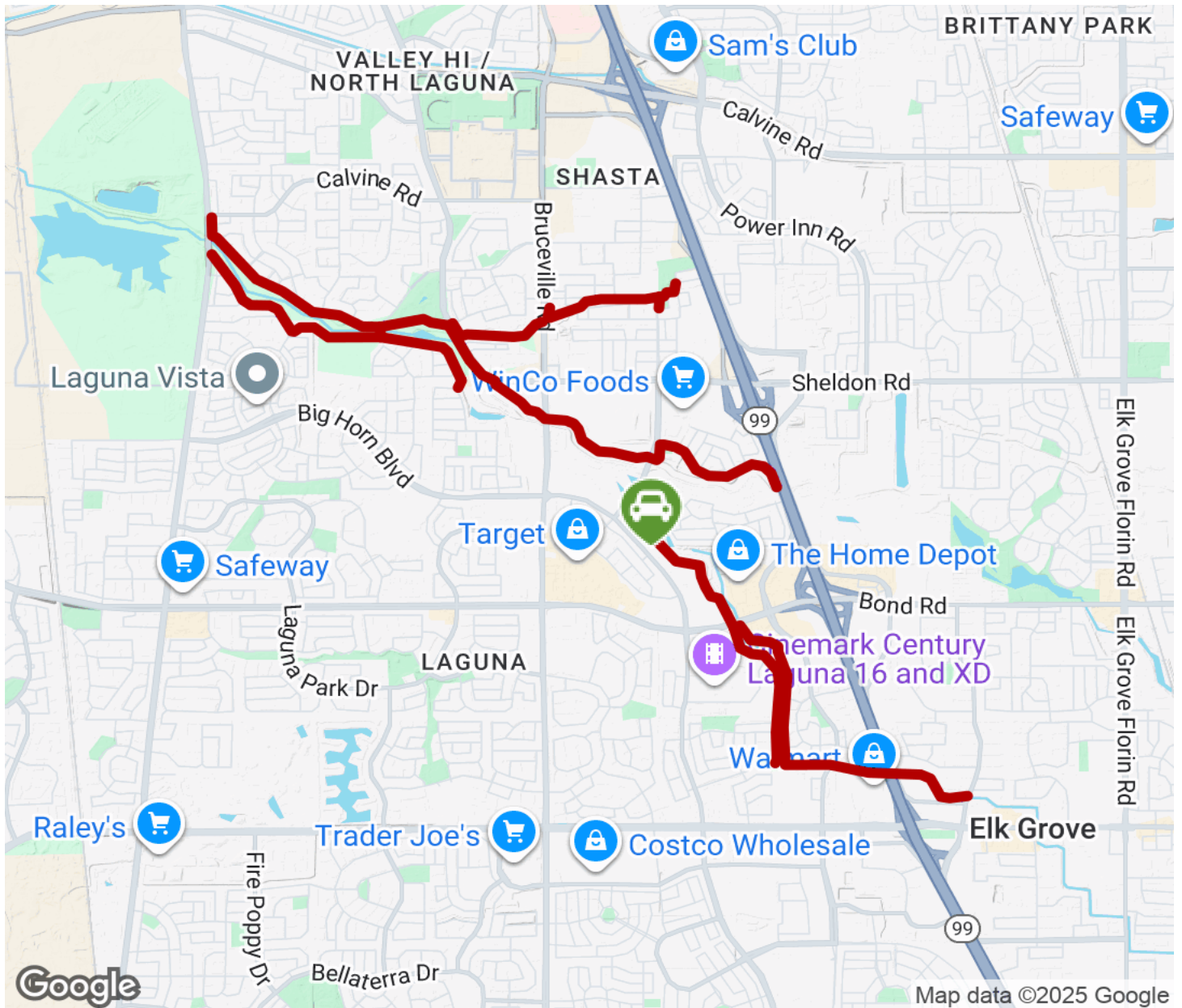
