Although short, the Bayshore Trail provides an important connection between two popular trails on Florida's west coast: the [Courtney Campbell Trail](#) and the [Ream Wilson Trail](#).

The paved north-south route lies on the eastern end of Clearwater and parallels Bayshore Boulevard; it is separated from the roadway by a wide grassy median. Much of the trail travels through pleasant tree-lined neighborhoods.

There is a bike repair station on the northeast corner of FL-60 and Bayshore Boulevard. It's across FL-60 from the west end of the Courtney Campbell Causeway Trail.

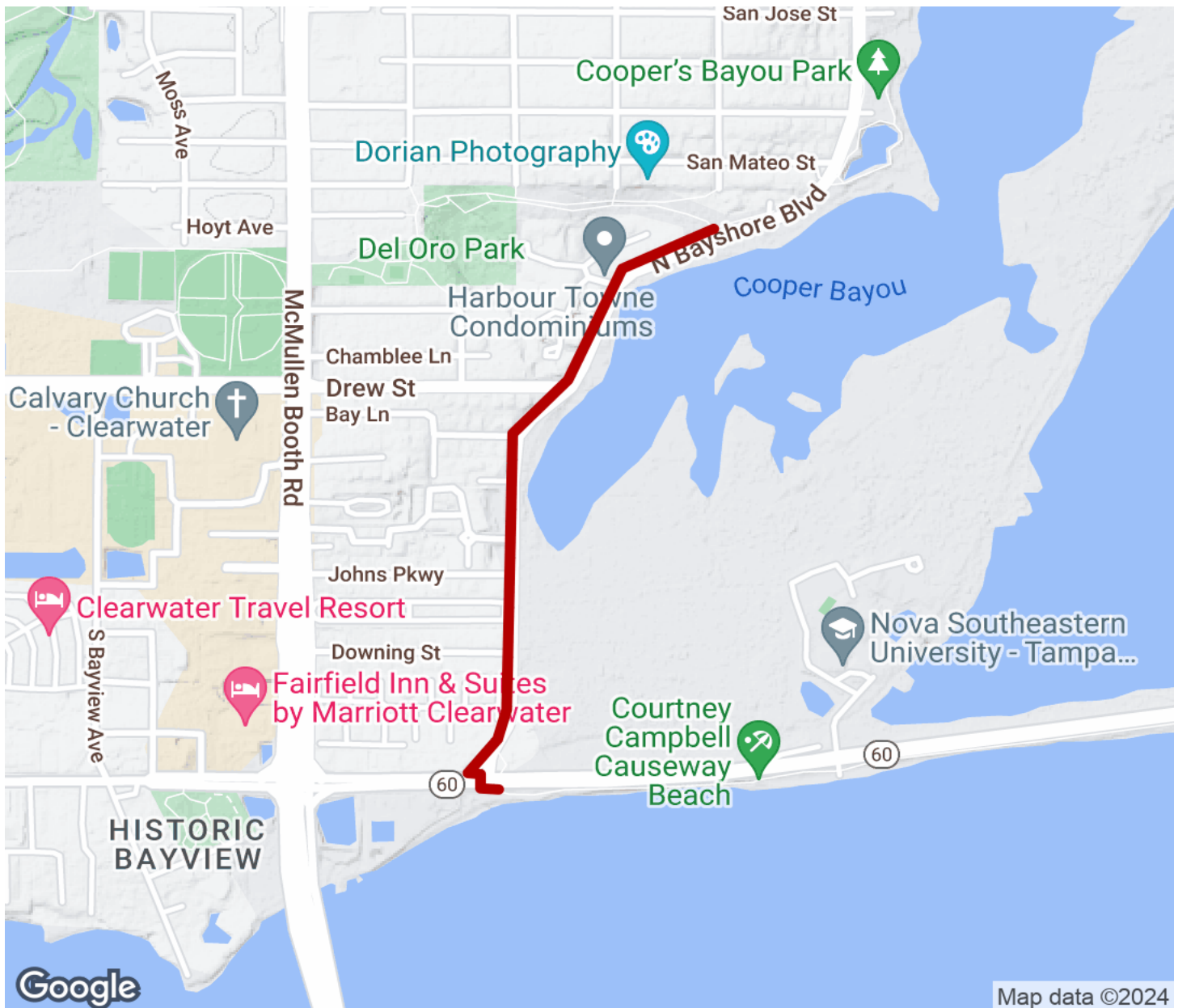
Parking & Trail Access
