The Rosedale South Trail offers a paved, tree-lined route along the former Pennsylvania Railroad in the western Indiana community



The Rosedale South Trail offers a paved, tree-lined route along the former Pennsylvania Railroad in the western Indiana community of Rosedale. It begins on the Central Street and travels southwest for just over a half mile.

When it opened in October 2014, it was the first segment of a larger 26-mile network of connecting rail-trails called the Covered Bridge Gateway Trail.

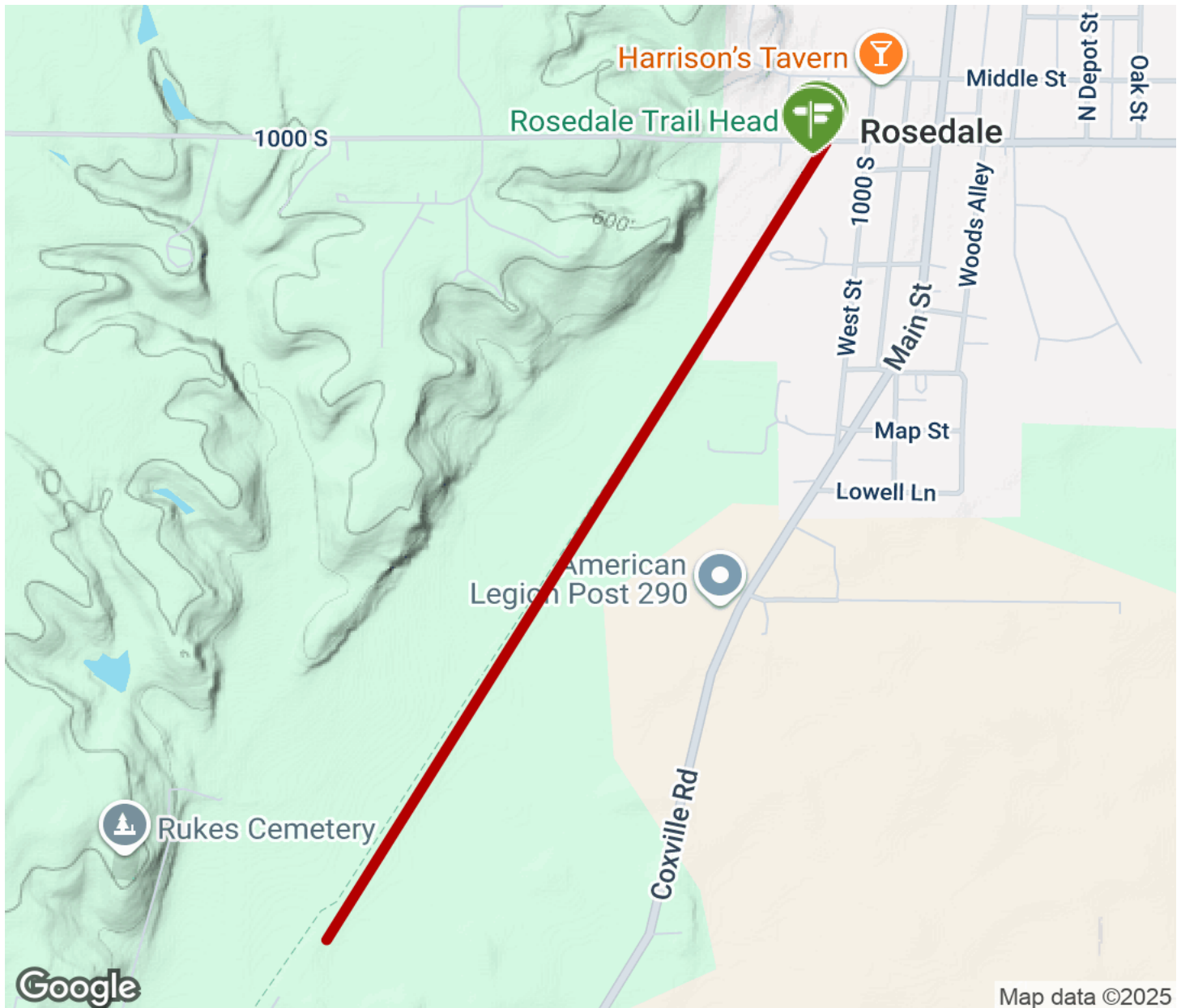
