Parke Community Rail Trail

The Parke Community Rail Trail offers a paved, tree-lined route along the former Pennsylvania Railroad in the western Indiana



The Parke Community Rail Trail offers a paved, tree-lined route along the former Pennsylvania Railroad in the western Indiana community of Rosedale. There is a southern and northern section of trail that are connected by an on-road route through town. When the trail first opened in October 2014, it was the first segment of a larger 26-mile network of connecting rail-trails called the Covered Bridge Gateway Trail.

The northern section of trail heads north until reaching Big Raccoon Creek while the southern section continues until Lambert Ave.
